

LENTEN HEALING: SPIRITUAL, PHYSICAL, & EMOTIONAL

St. Augustine's Lenten Recollection- March 23, 2022 (Link to the recording: https://bit.ly/Lentenrecolletion2022)

We would like to express our deepest gratitude to Monsignor Michael D. Harriman for delivering a very inspirational presentation on Lenten Healing: Spiritual, Physical, and Emotional during the Parish Lenten Recollection last Wednesday, March 23. We also would like to thank the 140+participants who attended the recollection both virtually and in-person, and to Deacon Nestor (Worship Commissioner) and all the Parish Ministries who collaborated together in bringing us this year's Lenten Recollection.

The recollection began with an acknowledgment by Monsignor Harriman that we have been living with long term low-grade trauma during this pandemic and how witnessing the daily struggle of Ukraine is so heartbreaking. He asked if there's an antidote to these pain and suffering. According to him, "As Christians, we sometimes refer to the great season of Lent as an antidote. We believe our destination is not the Good Friday, but the Glory of the Resurrection and this will happen with healing." He shared that healing comes to us by loving our enemies, when good overcomes evil, and during the season of Lent. He further elaborated by relating each one to scripture readings and sharing his personal stories. He also shared some ways how these healing can take place in our daily lives.

Monsignor Harriman also emphasized that Lent is an opportunity to break the new routine of life caused by the pandemic, and in the process, we may begin to ask ourselves: What do we need to add that is not normally in our lives? What do we need to stop that is commonplace in our living? He also challenged us to break the routine and to create that sacred space for ourselves so we may hear God's voice. He also spoke about how forgiveness breaks the cycle of violence and hatred and heals our hearts. He spoke about being grateful for the blessings that we often take for granted.


As we continue with the Lenten journey, here are the questions that we can reflect on and renew our souls as we prepare for the coming Holy Week: **SPIRITUAL**: How have our eyes found Christ in the fog of the pandemic crisis? **PHYSICAL**: How have we found the good health and grace as we physically struggle to cope with the unfolding trauma around us? **EMOTIONAL**: What we need now is <u>patience</u> and <u>trust</u>, <u>strength</u> and <u>courage</u>, a <u>peaceful heart</u> and <u>calm mind</u> to carry us through this time in our lives. Which one of these six qualities do I seek right now?

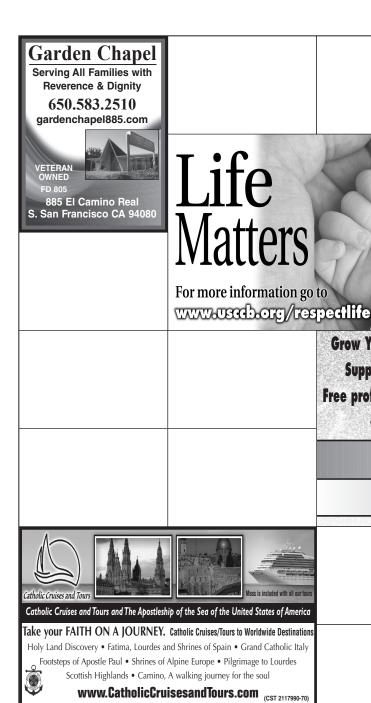

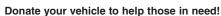


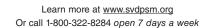
