# THE PASCHAL TRIDUUM CELEBRATION AT ST. AUGUSTINE CHURCH

Holy Week culminates in the Paschal Triduum, the three days commemorating the crucifixion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Paschal Mystery is Christ's work of redemption accomplished principally by His passion, death, and resurrection. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

Following are the highlights of the celebration of the Paschal Triduum at St. Augustine Church. After a hiatus of two years due to the pandemic, the washing of the feet at St. Augustine was re-enacted again on Holy Thursday. Following Pope Francis' decree of inclusion, the people selected for the washing of the feet in the liturgy of Holy Thursday represented a cross-section of St. Augustine's parish community: men, women, young and old.

On Good Friday, Father Ray Reyes led the procession to each Station of the Cross, and recited specific prayers in each station. These prayers offered an opportunity for the congregation to reflect on Jesus' death and the sacrifice He made for all of us. Following the Stations of the Cross was the Reflection on the 7 Last Words.

Father Ray and Deacon Nestor Fernandez expressed their appreciation to the speakers who reflected on the 7 Last Words: Evelyn Tavisora ("Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do"); Tommy Baniqued ("Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."); Brother Maurice Tokay (Jesus said to his mother: "Woman, this is your son." Then he said to the disciple: "This is your mother."); Shiony Mendoza ("My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"); Nerissa Broas ("I thirst."); Estelle Oloresisimo ("It is finished"); Sr. Nona Barairo ("Father, into your hands I commend my spirit.").

At the beginning of the service celebrating the Passion of our Lord, SAC clergy and deacons prostrated themselves in front of the altar. This gesture, aimed at demonstrating the abasement of humanity and the grief and sorrow of the church at the death of Jesus, set the tone for the rest of the service.

The Easter Vigil, which took place on Holy Saturday night, "is the greatest and most noble of all solemnities," and the mother of all vigils, according to Father Ray. It was a beautiful celebration! The liturgy began in darkness with the blessing of the fire in front of the church and the lighting of the Paschal Candle. Father Ray marked the alpha and omega symbols on the Paschal candle to show that Christ is the beginning and end of all things. The Paschal candle is an important symbol of our faith and plays a central role in our worship. The Paschal candle was lit from the new fire at the Easter Vigil. This new fire represents the light of the Risen Christ, shining in our darkest places. The church was kept dark at the beginning of the vigil and the Paschal candle was brought in. The Paschal candle was lit during the entire liturgy as a reminder that Jesus the Christ has risen from the dead and gives us light to guide us to Him.







