ELISA MACAPINLAC REYES

Feb 16, 1930 - April 28, 2022

ELISA MACAPINLAC REYES, 92, the last surviving matriarch of the Macapinlac and Reyes Family passed away peacefully, with family by her side, last April 28, 2022 at Laguna Honda Hospital, San Francisco, California, USA, where she became a resident after suffering from a large stroke in February of 2021. **ELISA** is the youngest daughter of the late Mayor Celestino Macapinlac and Maura Deang Pineda Macapinlac of Minalin, Pampanga, Philippines.

ELISA is survived by her beloved husband, **MARINO TOLENTINO REYES**, 94, a Filipino-war veteran during World War II; by her children, **Ramoncito** (Eileen), **Roman** (Evangeline), **Ricardo** (Geraldine), **Fr. Macapinlac; by her daughter, Rita M. Reyes; by her granddaughter, Marianne R. Magtoto; and by her great granddaughter, Kelly Mallari.

In 1954, **ELISA** completed a Bachelor of Science Degree in Education at Far Eastern University Manila and spent many years teaching at the Minalin Academy and at the Minalin Central Elementary School, Minalin, Pampanga, Philippines. **ELISA** was an active civic and religious leader and held important positions such as the Municipal NAMFREL Chairman, Santa Monica Parish Pastoral Council President and the Catholic Charismatic Renewal Servant Leader. She was actively involved with the Catholic Women's League, Cursillo Movement, Legion of Mary, Confraternity of Christian Doctrine (CCD), Men and Women of the Sacred Heart and the Secular Order of Discalced Carmelites (OCDS). In recognition of her dedication to Church service and her immense love for God, she received the prestigious "Archdiocesan Mother of the Year Award" bestowed on her by the Archbishop of San Fernando.

In 1995, **ELISA** immigrated with her family to the US and subsequently became a US Citizen. They resided in Woolfhouse, an independent living home in San Francisco. She started in their residence the Block Rosary that allowed the visit of the statue of Our Lady of Fatima into the different apartments to pray the Rosary and to study the Bible. They continued to be actively involved in St. Patrick's Church in San Francisco. She served as Eucharistic Minister and taught in the Religious Education of the parish as catechist. She was a dedicated member of the Legion of Mary, Our Lady of Fatima Group, St. Joseph Devotion, Sacred Heart Devotion and the Catholic Charismatic Renewal.

Married for 66 years, Elisa and Marino lived a beautiful and meaningful life. They were a model couple that inspired others. They were faithful to each other till the end. Their hearts were molded by the Sacred Heart of Jesus and enkindled by the Holy Spirit.

ELISA's great faith and piety, her wisdom, kindness, generosity, genuine love and passion to bring others closer to God are something that we will all miss. She will forever be in the hearts of those who have known her and experienced her love.

ELISA will be buried in the Santa Monica Catholic Cemetery after the Mass of the Resurrection on Saturday, May 14, at 3:00pm, at the Santa Monica Parish, Minalin, Pampanga, Philipines.
