

HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE 2022 OBERAMMERGAU PASSION PLAY AND PILGRIMAGE TO MEDJUGORJE AND OTHER MARIAN SITES IN EUROPE

Travelling along with 104 pilgrims from June 1-15 was truly an exhilarating experience. Our pilgrimage started when we left San Francisco on June 1st and arrived the following day in Munich. Our pilgrimage was both a spiritual and cultural journey and we're grateful for the opportunity to have experienced the grandeur of Europe's most high-powered sights and spectacular scenery, highlighted by the amazing castles, palaces and magnificent churches that have stood the test of time for centuries. And more importantly, the pilgrims felt truly blessed to be able to visit the sacred sites they sought to find healing for their spiritual, physical and emotional ailments.

The highlight of our pilgrimage was the Oberammergau Passion Play. The play dates back to 1634 when the plague was sweeping through Europe and claimed many lives. The people of Oberammergau gathered to ask God to spare their village and made a vow they would perform a Passion Play every ten years. From that time no further deaths occurred in the village and since then, the passion play in Germany has been regularly performed at Oberammergau except for a hiatus of two years due to the pandemic. The play consisted of two parts, with each part lasting for 2.5 hours and in-between, the pilgrims had a 3-hour break for dinner.

We're grateful for the presence of Father Ray and Father Rene. They led the morning prayers on the bus and our favorite part of the prayers is the daily reminder that we were pilgrims, not tourists. That we should be more forgiving and tolerant of the shortcomings of others because a pilgrimage is a spiritual journey.

Father Ray and Father Rene concelebrated daily masses at various historic churches we visited. They concelebrated Mass at the national shrine of the Black Madonna in Altotting, known for its many healings, so much so that it's called the Lourdes of Germany. The Black Madonna was carved from Lindenwood and noted for the miraculous healing of a young boy whose mother brought him before the statue after drowning and was brought back to life. Our pilgrimage took us to Salzburg's Hellbrun Palace and from there we proceeded to the Shrine of Maria Plain. And upon return to Salzburg, we were treated to a guided walking tour of 17th and 18th century buildings including the house where Mozart was born. We heard mass at the Cathedral and visited St. Peter's Abbey, next to the cemetery featured in the Sound of Music movie. We proceeded to Vienna and on the way, we stopped in the amazing Melk Abbey, a baroque-style structure surrounded by gorgeous Renaissance homes and winding streets reminiscent of the Middle Ages.

Budapest is one of the most beautiful cities we visited. On our last night there, we were treated to a river cruise on the Danube River. As we glide past the iconic landmarks on the riverbank, the pilgrims couldn't help but marvel and admire the talent and creativity of the individuals who contributed to the grand architectural landmarks. The House of Parliament, built in eclectic and neo-Gothic style between 1885 and 1904 to house both legislative chambers, is a fine memento to the quest for grandeur and pomp that Hungary pursued in preparation for its millenary celebrations in 1896. On the final stretch of our pilgrimage, we visited the small parish community of Medjugorje, a small village where our Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to six visionaries on June 24, 1981. We were led to the Apparition Hill by two spiritual guides who informed us that climbing the hill could be a challenge for some of the pilgrims, especially for those who are not physically fit. The trail is rough and rock-studded but most of the pilgrims were able to make it to the top. A white statue of the Queen of Peace marks the site of the first apparition in 1981. Those who were physically fit were able to climb Cross Mountain and made the Way of the Cross as they ascended the mountain. Those who stayed behind participated in the "Stations of the Cross," led by a local spiritual guide.
