A 2019 Pew Research Center survey revealed that two-thirds of Catholics no longer believe in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. To restore belief on the Real Presence for the majority of our Catholic sisters and brothers is a major task. This is the goal of the National Eucharistic Revival in the United State that we at Saint Augustine Catholic Church are participating for the next three years.

UPDATES ON THE SYNOD ON SYNODALITY

St. Augustine Parish took part in the San Francisco Diocesan Phase Consultation by participating in the online Disciple Maker Index (DMI) Survey back in January, 2022.

A total of 478 surveys were completed (411 online survey and 67 paper survey). That's a 38% response rate based on the average number of weekly Mass attendees at our church. The DMI Survey consisted of 75 questions where parishioners were asked to reflect on their current parish involvement and individual spiritual growth.

We're grateful to Rita Liu, head of the Hospitality Ministry, for serving as the parish liaison during this diocesan process. At the Parish Pastoral Council Executive Meeting last Tuesday, Rita did a quick presentation on the survey results that showed respondents' current stages are in their Catholic journey and spiritual growth. She also presented the areas of parish strengths and opportunities, as well as survey responses on the Key Driver questions that are statistically significant with respect to "a parishioner's likelihood to recommend the parish, say the parish is helping them grow spiritually, and frequency with which they are sharing their faith." \

The Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) will begin to review these results as well as the summary report from the Archdiocese to see how SAC can apply the recommendations for the parishioners and the parish ministries in the years ahead.
