"Laetare" Sunday is the 4th Sunday in the season Of Lent. The date is moveable as it depends on the date of Easter. The date of Easter changes annually based on lunar activity. "Laetare" Sunday is a day of "rejoicing", a day of celebration within the season of Lent. It gets its name from the first few words (incipit) of the traditional Latin entrance (Introit) for the Mass of the Day. Laetare Jerusalem ("Rejoice, O Jerusalem") is Latin from Isaiah 66:10. The clergy vestment on this Sunday is the color rose.

We are now at the heart of our Lenten journey of conversion. As those preparing for Baptism at Easter celebrate the second scrutiny today, let our hearts be one with theirs. As we prepare to renew our baptismal promises at Easter, let today's word scrutinize our minds and hearts. Let today's living word be the way that leads us out of the confusing mess that sin puts us in.

Let today be the day that we are found.
