The City of South San Francisco adopted a **Child Care Master Plan in 2022**, developed in tandem with the City's new General Plan.

The Child Care Master Plan identifies over 100 actionable recommendations to improve the childcare landscape in South San Francisco. One of the keystone strategies is that a Joint Advisory Committee of the Child Care Master Plan (JACCCMP) be formed to steer prioritization and implementation of the recommendations in the Plan.

We are delighted to launch the formation of this critical steering committee, which will be led by Mayor Flor Nicolas and Councilmember James Coleman, supported by childcare consultant Kathleen White.

It is important to note that the JACCMP will gather input from many stakeholders and committee members.


