



52nd PPC Meeting Minutes Thursday, 28 May 2026

Parish Hall Update: Restroom and Church Shade

Summary:

Father Ray reported that the parish hall project is pending feedback from the Archdiocese, specifically Mr. John Christian (Director of Real Property Support Corporation-RPSC), due to ongoing settlement negotiations. The group plans to complete restroom construction before classes begin in August but is currently awaiting approval from the Finance Council and Board.

✔ Key Action Items

- ✦ Follow up with Archdiocese on parish hall approval
- ✦ Goal: begin restroom work ASAP once approved.
- ✦ Target completion: before August (start of classes)
- ✦ Temporary use of church restrooms during construction

Legion of Mary Update (Write-up Deferred)

Summary:

Deacon Nestor was absent, so the item was skipped. Members shared testimonials highlighting strong community impact through ministries such as grief support, outreach, and evangelization, including active door-to-door efforts.

✔ Key Action Items

- ✦ The group noted the strong community impact of ongoing efforts.
- ✦ Denise will highlight the Legion of Mary's evangelization work and Vivian about grieving ministry to Deacon Nestor.

Franciscan Jubilee Year Committee

Summary:

The meeting highlighted progress on the Saint Francis Jubilee Committee, noting they are ahead of diocesan plans. Father Ray introduced a youth-involved committee set to meet June 2 to focus on spiritual growth, peace, environmental care, and service to the poor.

✔ Key Action Items

✦ **Jubilee Committee Kickoff (June 2):** Support the launch of the new committee, which will focus on spirituality, environmental stewardship, and outreach initiatives.

✦ **Rosabel – Donut Sunday:** Coordinate with the Franciscan Jubilee Year Committee to plan hosting a Donut Sunday in July or August to increase parish visibility.

✦ **Rosabel – Speaker Event Proposal:** Prepare a proposal for Dr. Calderon's next talk, "*Blessings on Brokenness*," and coordinate with her for a possible July event aligned with the Jubilee Year

✦ **Rosabel – Coordination with Fr. Ray:** Notify Fr. Ray when Dr. Calderon's availability is confirmed so both can be invited (including virtually) to present the proposal to the transition committee.

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St. Vincent de Paul (Parish-Wide Clothing Drive Update)

Summary:

✓ Key Action Items

- ✦ **Goal:** Raise funds for outreach through resale of donated clothing.
- ✦ **Communication:** All PPC members should clearly share and reinforce donation guidelines across their ministries. Items must be clean, gently worn, and wearable; undergarments and household goods are not accepted.
- ✦ **Flyer Update & Promotion:** Revise the flyer to highlight the June 13 and 27 drive dates and ensure clear messaging about donation requirements to support effective promotion and preparation.

Sanjay announced the Class of 2026’s final youth group meeting and upcoming graduation:

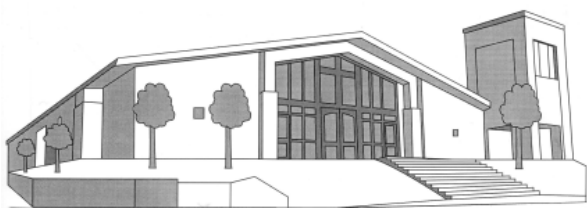
- Graduation Mass: May 31, 12:30 PM
