

The time capsule containing the collective prayers, petitions, memories of joys and challenges of the parishioners of St. Augustine, along with the permit, architectural and structural drawings for the construction of the shrine of St. Monica, was finally sealed and blessed in a historic celebration last Sunday after the 9:00 AM Mass. Father Ray Reyes blessed the time capsule before it was encapsulated and prayed for the continued intercession of both St. Augustine and St. Monica to keep all parishioners safe, to enable them to overcome the difficulties in life, to keep their love and compassion for one another, and above all, to remain steadfast in their faith and love of God.

Father Ray thanked Jizelle Oliva for the beautiful label she created for the time capsule and he acknowledged the extraordinary work of two Knights of Columbus parishioners, Felipe Cristobal and Manny Almojuela, who went above and beyond expectations to ensure the successful completion of St. Monica's shrine. The image of St. Monica was placed on top of the sealed time capsule but there are still additional works that need to be done to complete the shrine. After the blessing, Father Ray reflected on the significance of the time capsule – that it will surely bring joy and inspire the future generation when they unseal the time capsule and discover how the generation before them was able to find joy in trying times through their strong faith in God and through the power of prayers.

St. Joseph: Faithful Protector of Mother and Child


