 **Limits Apply**

- South San Francisco residents only.
- One carload allowed per household.
- Cars and pickups only. NO box trucks or trailers.

STATION #1 (Small Items - SSF Scavenger)

- Clothes, shoes, accessories
- Toys, games, puzzles, stuffed animals
- Linens, pillows, tablecloths, fabric
- Shoes, lamps, vacuums
- Hardback and paperback books
- Records, tapes, CDs, videos, DVDs
- Crafts, mugs, vases, pictures/frames, baskets

STATION #2 (Large Items - SSF Scavenger)

- Mattresses, box springs, bed frames
- Furniture, bicycles
- Washers, dryers, water heaters
- Toilets
- Gardening, exercise equipment
- Strollers
- Gas-powered lawnmowers, tools, BBQs (drain gas beforehand)

STATION #3 (E-waste - ZARC)

- Camcorders, TV's, VCR
- Cell and desk phones

- Microwaves and small kitchen appliances (working or not)

STATION #4 (Paper Shredding - SSF Scavenger)

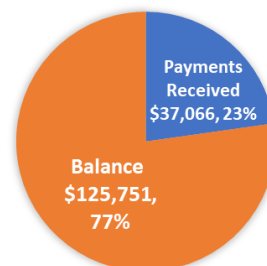
