Matthew 16:13-20

Jesus names Simon Peter as the “rock” upon which he will build his church.

Jesus asks his disciples what people are saying about his identity.

In today’s Gospel, Peter’s recognition of Jesus’ identity is credited to a revelation by God.

The use of the term “church” in today’s Gospel is one of only three such occurrences in Matthew’s Gospel. Peter in this Gospel is being credited as the foundation of the Church, a privilege granted to him because of his recognition of Jesus’ identity. The Church continues to be grounded in the faith that Jesus Christ is Lord.

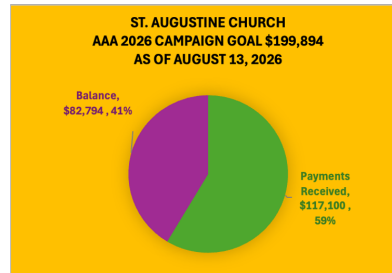

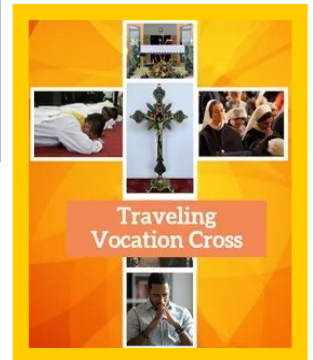
