### Simbang Gabi and the Advent Recollection at St. Augustine Church

Advent is a time of preparation and anticipation. The Advent season invites us to step away from the "commercialization" of the holiday season when people indulge in endless shopping and parties, and consider focusing instead on the reason why we are celebrating Christmas. This was front and center in the mind of Father Ray Reyes when he invited Father Dave Pettingill to be the speaker at the Advent Recollection held on December 18. Father Ray thought it's important to make time in our schedules to prayerfully observe Advent by listening to inspirational talks and participating in the Simbang Gabi. The Advent Recollection was intended to complement the celebration of Simbang Gabi, a novena of Advent Masses in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary to help prepare us spiritually for Christmas. The event on December 18 started with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Adoration. It was followed by the introduction of the Guest Speaker by Deacon Nes Fernandez. He introduced Father Dave as a renowned speaker and homilist, a strong advocate of Vatican II Council, former principal at Marin Catholic High School, and former professor at St. Patrick Seminary and University. Father Dave's talk focused on the readings from the three Advent Characters: The Prophet Isaiah (before the exile, during the exile, and after the exile); Matthew 11:2-6 (John the Baptist) and Luke 11:27-28 (Mary). In his reflection, he connected all three readings and emphasized that Jesus is the embodiment or the "blueprint" for LIVING, DYING and RISING. For most of us, understanding the readings pose a real challenge and sometimes the message gets lost in translation. Thanks to Father Dave, he clearly showed that all three readings are connected. The Prophet Isaiah spoke in the voice of God and called the people of Israel to repentance, to prepare them for the coming of His Son. Isaiah also prophesied about a person in the desert who will prepare the way for the Lord. This prophecy foreshadowed the life of John the Baptist, who played an important role in preparing the groundwork for the ministry of Jesus Christ.

The afternoon session focused on Mary. According to Father Dave, Mary was transformed from being a mother to a "Perfect Disciple." Mary showed us how to evolve because change is part of being alive. Mary showed us that she was adaptable. She truly became a model of evolution. As Christians, we should all strive to be like Mary. We are part of a pilgrim church that is constantly evolving so we need to adapt to the changes of the world. In the words of Father Dave, Catholics need to loosen up. We don't need to dwell on the past; instead set our sight on the future where there is hope. Despite the gloom and sadness surrounding us due to the pandemic, we see "resurrection" in the doctors, nurses, medical practitioners and caregivers who are giving their all to save others.

The Advent Season is also a great time to reconcile with God through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Thanks to our clergy, confession was offered to the Recollection attendees during Adoration, both in the morning and afternoon sessions. Our special thanks to Father Dave who showed us that by living one's faith more fully, and sharing it with those around us, it will allow all of us to make Advent a worthy preparation for the celebration of our Lord Jesus' birth and the joyful anticipation for His coming again to the world.







