ST. AUGUSTINE SPECIAL EDUCATION CATECHIST HONORED BY AN INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION AND PUBLICATION IN THE PHILIPPINES



Overtaxed and undermanned, many of America's mainstream teachers are at a crossroads. They yearn for time, compassion, and the precious gift of support. It is one of the greatest professions. Yet, although teachers love what they do, extensive deficiencies are likely if their needs remain unheard.

Furthermore, there is one group of widely unrecognized, overlooked, and undervalued educators: **Special Education (Sped) Teachers**.

Audrey Ann B. Bayogoss is one of our credentialed Faith Formation Sped Catechists here at St. Augustine.

Aside from being a Special Day Class educator at the Jefferson School District and teaching at John F. Kennedy Elementary School in Daly City, CA, she still finds time to volunteer her services every Saturday, which she has done since 2020.

Audrey Ann does an excellent job in compassionately preparing students with special needs for the Sacrament of Reconciliation and 1st Holy Communion.

Audrey Ann has successfully prepared a diverse group of students with individual Education programs (IEP) ranging from 3rd to 8th grade, who have Autism (ASD); Down Syndrome (DS); Intellectual Disability (ID), Speech and Language Disorder/Disability (SLD) and Global Delayed Disorder/Disability (GDD).

Audrey Ann earned her Master of Arts degree in Special Education from the University of the Philippine in Quezon City and the University of the Visayas in Cebu, Philippines. She earned her Bachelor of Arts in Psychology from the Philippine Normal University in Manila and earned local credentials from the University of California in San Diego, University of Phoenix in Arizona, and the national University in Pleasant Hill.

She brings with her over 28 years of experience in teaching children ages 2-10 years old, as a Sped Therapist/Teacher and a Montessori Early Childhood Educator. She was also a Consultant and Case Manager for children with special needs.

According to an article found on the Wiley University Services website, "Special education (Sped) teachers have a higher rate of burn-out than is found in most other professions."

The various disabilities of Sped students with whom Sped teachers teach, increases the strain associated with the job; yet Audrey Ann's dedication toward her students outweigh the challenges she faces each day.

It is because of this, that she was awarded the **2023 Outstanding Global Teacher Award** by an International Organization and Aloysian Publication in the Philippines, last December 2023 and was recently awarded the **2024 Dakilang Filipino Award** as the **Best Outstanding Special Education Specialist** for "teaching students with extensive and support need."

Please join us in congratulating our Catechist, Audrey Ann B. Bayogoss, on these prestigious awards and recognition; and for reaching the pinnacle of excellence in her chosen field.
