9 WAYS TO PRAY (a continuation)

A.C.T.S.

This acronym stands for Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, and Supplication. You can use the acronym to help you pray for those who are poor and vulnerable and for help in discerning how to respond.

Adoration. Praise God for his love of humanity, and for creating each human being with dignity. Express wonder for life and beauty, and the basic goodness of human beings.

Confession. Express your sorrow for an issue — a collective or social sin of humanity — that is facing the world today. This could include poverty, abortion, environmental destruction, or another issue. Take a moment to also recognize how you may have participated in the collective sin or issue, perhaps by your failure to do somethings about it.

Thanksgiving. Thank God for his forgiveness and for maintaining hope in the world and in humans despite our failures. Express thanks for the talents that God has given humans and the inspiration to use these talents to address issues like the one you have mentioned.

Supplication. Supplication is another word for intercession, or asking. Ask God to help bring about a positive solution to the issue you have identified — for an end to the social injustice. Ask him to help you see how you are called to be involved in addressing the issue. Invite the Spirit into your heart to inspire you.

For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission

Our Holy Father Pope Francis has invited the Catholic Church to embark on a journey together. Through listening and discernment rooted in the Holy Spirit, the entire people of God are being called to contribute to a process by which the Church deepens in understanding of Her mission and looks toward the future.

How to participate in Synod

Our Holy Father Pope Francis is asking the People of God to participate fully and authentically.

The Archdiocese of San Francisco has kicked-off the local synodal process this month by asking every Catholic to participate in the Disciple Maker Index survey between now and **February 14**. The process will continue in February and March with engagement sessions offered throughout the Archdiocese. The **Disciple Maker Index (DMI)** survey is a nationally recognized survey administered at parishes around the United States and Canada since 2013 by The Catholic Leadership Institute. The results from this survey will provide baseline feedback from which content for engagement sessions will be developed.

STEP 1: Complete the Disciple Maker Index Survey by Feb 14

The DMI Survey is an anonymous survey that allows an individual to reflect upon their faith journey (spiritual growth and discipleship), as well as how much one is journeying (participation) with the parish. This online survey must be completed in one sitting (~10-15 minutes). There are no right or wrong answers. Sharing Responsibility for Our Common Mission



California Mortgage Relief Program Up to \$80,000 in Mortgage Relief for Qualified Applicants.

The State of California recently launched a mortgage relief program to help homeowners who fall behind on mortgage payments due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Eligible households can qualify for up to \$80,000 in relief for their past due housing-related bills. The payments will be made directly to the homeowner's mortgage provider.

Homeowners will **NOT** need to repay the state for funds received. The State has set aside \$1 billion for this program through the American Rescue Plan that was passed in March 2021.

To find out if you are eligible for the program and to apply, please visit Ca-MortgageRelief.org. For homeowners who do not have access to a computer or internet, you can contact your mortgage provider or call a HUD-certified housing counselor at 1-800-569-4287. There is no deadline to apply for this program as the program will end once all funds are exhausted.
