

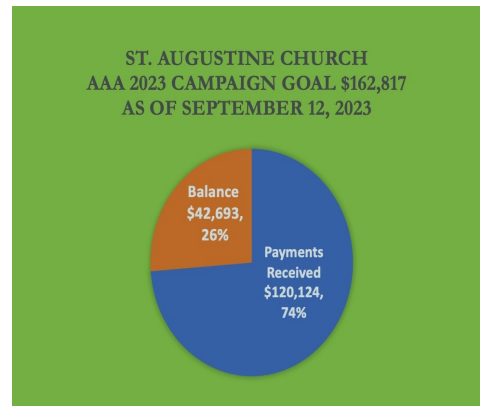

The Office of Worship will be offering training for new and experienced Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Readers over two consecutive Saturdays during October & November 2023.

During the first workshop, ministers are introduced to sacramental theology, particularly that of the Eucharist. During the second workshop, presenters who are experienced and trained offer spiritual and technical direction for the minister's specific liturgical role. Workshops conclude with preparing Extraordinary Ministers for bringing Holy Communion to the sick and homebound, and Readers with coaching in proclamation and oral interpretation. This training fulfills the requirement of the Archdiocese to be certified every three years for these ministries.

Registration: \$20.00 pre-registered or \$25.00 for same-day registrants.
