In today's reading in the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus addresses a common occurrence in the Christian community: a dispute between two members of the Church. Jesus does not discourage disagreement with the community of the Church; he acknowledges the reality of conflict and error and offers his disciples a means for addressing such matters. It is in the conclusion to this teaching that the message of hope is found: Jesus is present with the community and will guide the community in its relations. If decisions are taken in prayer, then the community can be assured of God's assistance.

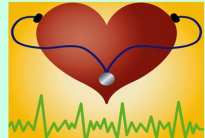

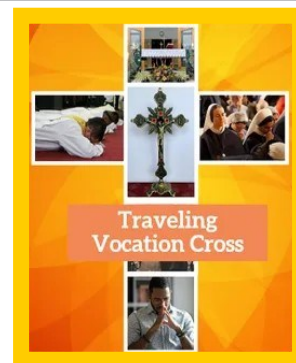
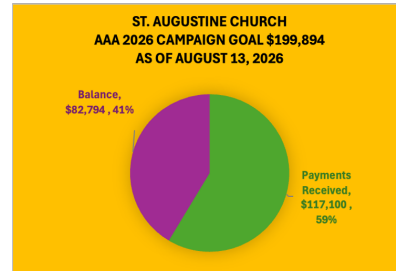
