

Numbers 21:4b-9 Psalm 78:1bc-2, 34-35, 36-37, 38 Philippians 2:6-11 John 3:13-17

In John's Gospel, Jesus' death on the cross as well as his resurrection and return to the Father are one event. For him, the cross is a sign of exaltation. The serpent that Moses lifted in the desert to offer healing to those injured by snake bites prefigures Jesus' being lifted up on the cross, bringing salvation.

The eternal life God offers through Jesus is not life without end, it is live lived in the unending presence of God. That is why it can begin now in this life. The world to which God sends the Son is not a place but those people who are at odds which Jesus and God. Jesus is sent to this world as a gift. Only believers accept the gift.

Finally, God's judgment on the world is not a future cosmic event but a present reality. God sent the Son out of love for the world. However, the world must decide to accept him. Those who accept him have eternal life now at the moment of decision. Those who reject him don't.



Our CCSF Adult Day Centers Offer Hope and Compassion for Seniors and their Families

Catholic Charities Adult Day Services (San Francisco and San Mateo) offers seniors with memory loss and adults with disabilities a safe place to gather, socialize, and have fun. A typical day for our seniors might include anything from chair exercise to watercolor painting, from ring toss to volleyball.

Staff provides a supervised, safe, and friendly environment where seniors can interact with friends, increase their independence, and improve the quality of their lives.

The Caregiver Support Group (Adult Day San Mateo) is a monthly gathering for family members with a loved one diagnosed with cognitive impairment. Co-sponsored by the Alzheimer's Association, the support group provides a safe place for caregivers to share their feelings, frustrations, needs, and concerns, and discuss the inherent challenges of the caregiving journey. The group also provides coping methods, practical caregiving strategies, resources, and support for one another.

The Memory Café (Adult Day San Mateo) provides an accepting and accessible environment where recently diagnosed individuals with cognitive impairments and their care partners can enjoy time together socializing, connecting, and creating new memories. Participants enjoy meaningful, joyful activities that enhance the ability for individuals and families to navigate more effectively through their journey of care.

This is to inform you that **FR ERIC G VELANDRIA SJ** died of a heart attack around 1:30 am today in Grosseto, Italy. Fr Eric, 66, was on vacation with Fr Albert Alejo SJ and another Jesuit, and had gone to sleep when he complained of chest pains. He tried to go back to sleep but apparently fell to the floor. By the time he was discovered, the medical staff who responded could no longer revive him. Fr Eric entered the Society in 1985 (40 years ago) and was ordained to the presbyterate in 1996 (29 years ago). **Requiescat in pace**.

Following Jesuit protocol, Fr Eric's remains will be buried in Italy, where he died. Wake and funeral details in Rome are still being arranged.

Locally, a Memorial Mass for Fr Eric will be celebrated at 8:00 pm on Tuesday, 9 September, at the Oratory of St Ignatius in Loyola House of Studies, Ateneo de Manila University campus, Quezon City.

The usual suffrages are requested for Fr Eric: all members of the Province should offer for him one Mass, all members of his local Community should offer two Masses (see **Phil. Prov. Jesuit Ordo**, pp. v-vi).
