May is National Bike Month! **Remember to Practice** **Bicycle Safety**

In partnership with the City of South San Francisco Police Department and the San Mateo County Office of Education, the City of South San Francisco is pleased to donate reflective tags, LED bicycle lights, and bicycle safety best practices to anyone who wants to be safe on the road! Items are available for pickup at the South San Francisco Police Department located at One Chestnut Avenue, South San Francisco.



Use Bike Lights and Reflectors At Night, It's the Law!

Using lights and reflectors at night is required by state law. Riders should also avoid wearing dark clothing and have the following equipment:

- A white headlight visible from the front
- A red reflector or a red light with a built-in reflector (can be solid or flashing) visible from the rear
- A white or yellow reflector on each pedal or on the bicyclist's shoes or ankles that is visible from the front and the rear
- A white or yellow reflector on the front half of the bicycle, and a red or white reflector on each side of the back half of the bicycle.

Light It Up!

Bike lights are safety devices that can help make you more visible to vehicles on the road! You can drastically improve your chances of being seen by drivers by wearing a reflective light or having one on your bike.



Be SEEN During the Day!

It's just as important to be visible to vehicles during the day as it is at night. Though not required by law, consider using bike lights, preferably flashing, during the day to be more visible to vehicles.

Don't Forget Your Helmet!

In an accident, heads are more vulnerable to serious and even fatal injury. That is why it is always important to always wear your helmet while riding your bicycle and make sure it's your right size. *Did you know?* It's required by law to wear a helmet for all children under the age of 18!

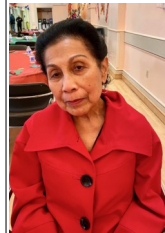

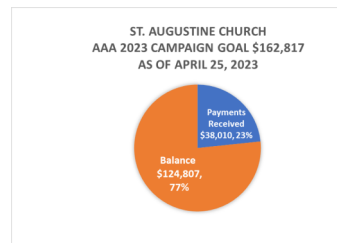
