



Join us at the SSF Farmers' Market on May 20, 2023, as the South San Francisco Fire Department provides community training highlighting the value of hands-

**SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO, Calif., May 16, 2023** – The City of South San Francisco's Parks and Recreation Department was recognized by the California Park & Recreation Society (CPRS) at its Annual District 4 Banquet, which honored unique innovation and outstanding individuals for their professional and volunteer contributions to the field of parks, recreation, and human ser-

vices.

Among the four awards received, Francisca "Fran" Guevarra, a long time parishioner at Saint Augustine Catholic Church, was one of the award recipients for Professional Merit.

After 17 years of service in the Parks and Recreation Department's Senior Services Program in South San Francisco, Fran Guevarra recently retired. Since joining the team in 2005, Fran has been instrumental in many aspects of the Senior Services programs.

She helped write and develop the volunteer program manual and secure and track volunteers. She also assisted with the planning and implementation of special events, such as the Senior Health Fair, Volunteer Appreciation Luncheon, Holiday Boutique, and was the leading force behind the "Valentine's for the Troops" event for many years.


