Seattle Food Tech, Inc. DBA Rebellyous Foods is seeking quotes for a comprehensive techno-economic analysis (TEA) of our novel processing system for the production of plant-based meat. Rebellyous has completed design, initial build and testing of a fully continuous, automated and chilled dough substrate processing system that can produce a wide range of plant-based meat products at 60% lower cost vs. conventional methods. Quotes are being sought from qualified firms or independent experts in food manufacturing, novel equipment assessments and tools such as TECHTEST.

Quotes for services should include analysis to compare Rebellyous' technology with the existing/traditional dough making methods being produced in similar manufacturing facilities or with similar methods.

A techno-economic analysis quote should include:

- Ability to meet a June 1, 2024 deadline. Include a timeline in your quote for possible phases of analysis, and cost for each phase.
- Assessment of the overall value of our novel technology system.
- Collaboration with an LCA consultant to identify performance factors that lead to emissions and cost improvements throughout the technology's lifetime.
- Provide narrative on your ability to create a methodology for data collection for novel equipment deployed for less than 3 months.
- Customer report and any additional analysis options offered.
