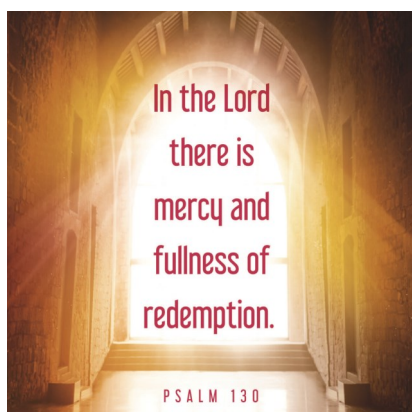

RCIA is the process in which Adults are brought into the Catholic Church by receiving the Sacraments of Initiation...Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil.
