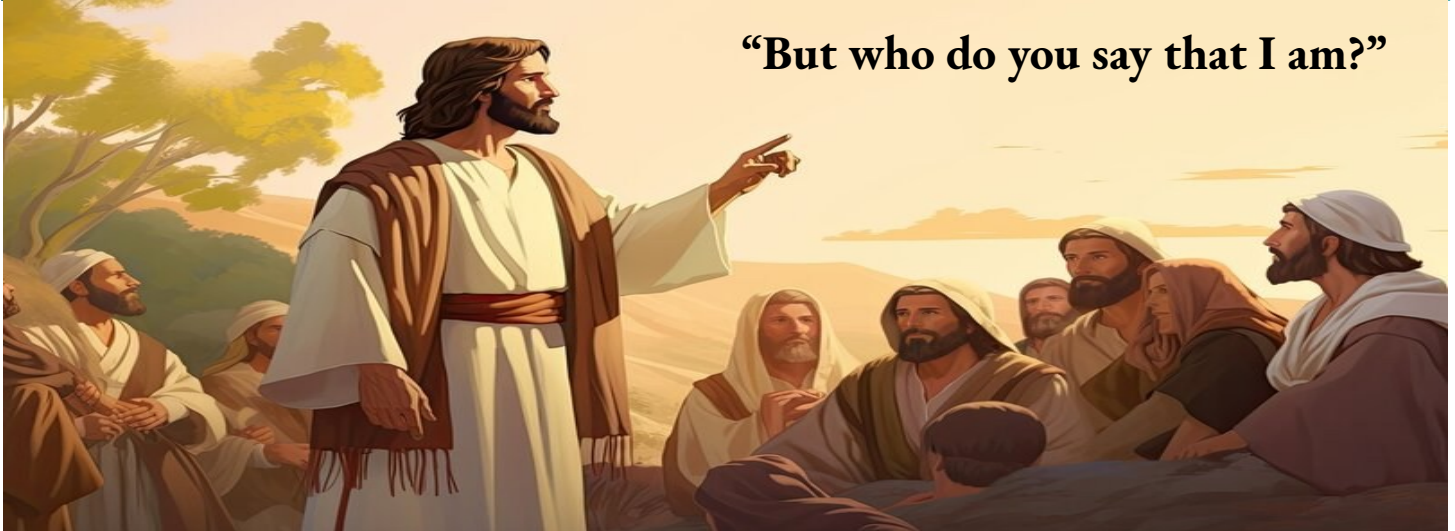

Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul Sunday, June 29, 2025
