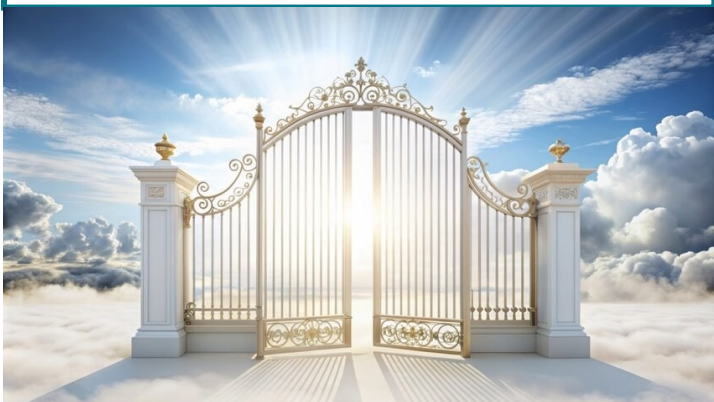

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke Jesus passed through towns and villages, teaching as he went and making his way to Jerusalem. 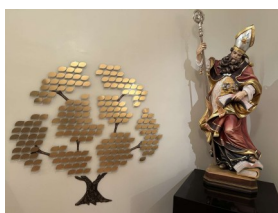
