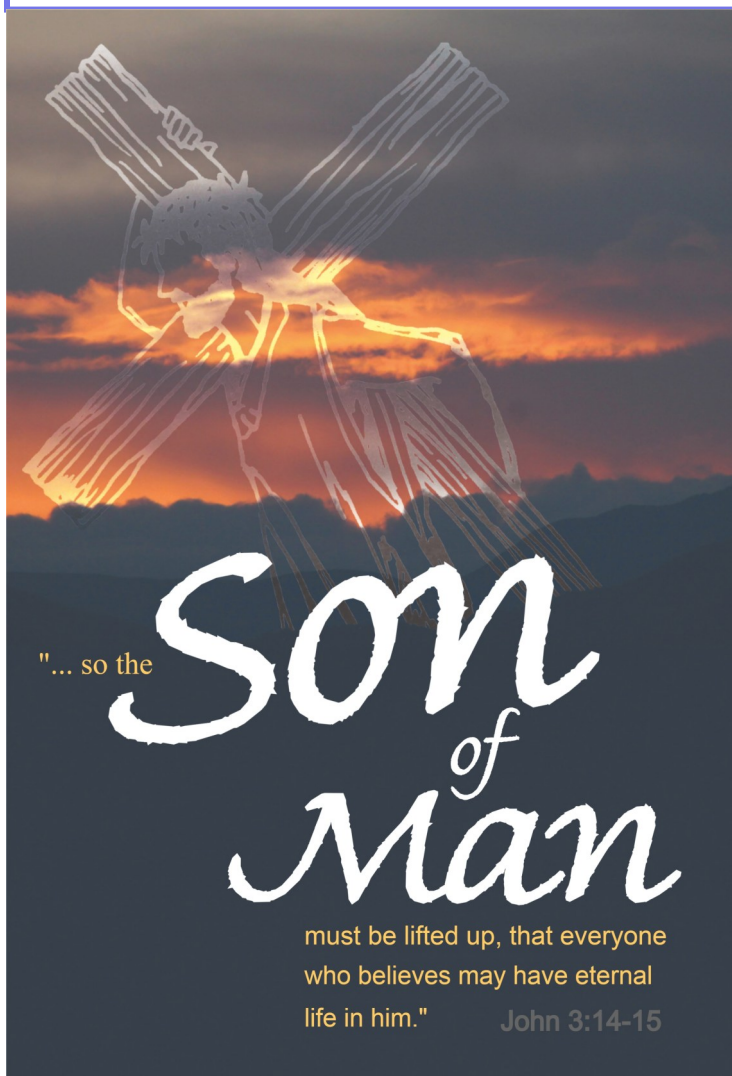

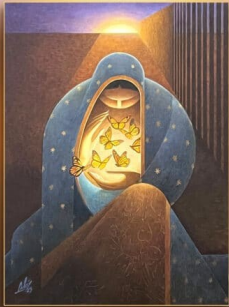

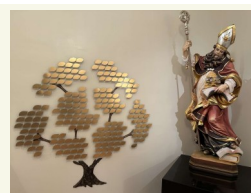
Mortgage Relief for Homeowners Who Lost Their Home to Disaster
