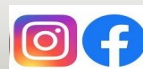

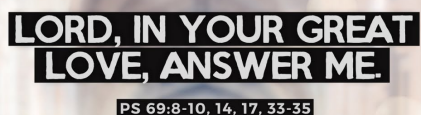

### TOGETHER WE WORK TO PROTECT AND REPORT

through our **Safeguard the Children Programs** on prevention and reporting, fingerprinting and background checks, which are led by lay staff and volunteers.

##### OVER 440,000

Adults trained in abuse prevention and reporting

##### 165,000 ANNUALLY

Each year, Catholic school and religious education students taught boundary awareness and tools for reporting

##### OVER 257,000

Adults fingerprinted and background checked

#### WE TAKE ACTION

Strict protocols for handling all allegations

##### LAW ENFORCEMENT

Allegations of sexual misconduct reported to law enforcement; fully cooperate in investigations

##### REMOVAL & INVESTIGATION

Credibly accused removed; pending investigations; clergy allegations reviewed by independent Clergy Misconduct Oversight Board

##### TRANSPARENT COMMUNICATION

Announcements made in parishes or schools where the accused individual served

### WE SUPPORT VICTIM-SURVIVORS

The Office of Victims Assistance Ministry advocates for victim-survivors in the Archdiocese. This ministry provides support for victim-survivors and their families, and ensures reporting of sexual misconduct to law enforcement.



### WE VET CLERGY

Clergy and Seminarians comply with Safe Environment requirements and all visiting priests and deacons must present a Statement of Suitability.

### ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

Clergy or lay persons, if found to have abused a minor, are permanently removed.
