OCIA is the process in which Adults are brought into the Catholic Church by receiving the Sacraments of Initiation...Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil. The process lasts at least one liturgical year and involves a series of Rites, studies, retreat, and discussions. DID YOU KNOW?

Body safety information for young children

Children should know the difference between "okay" and "not okay" or "good" and "bad" touches — touches that are welcome and comforting, and those that are intrusive, unwanted, painful, or uncomfortable. Children should know that they have the right to say "no" to being touched, even to adults, and that no children or adults should touch their private parts unless in very specific circumstances, and for a healthy purpose. This is where it can be helpful to discuss "safe adults," like doctors, who check our bodies to help keep us healthy, and only in the presence of a parent or trusted adult.
