PASTOR'S COLUMN



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As we move into the heart of summer, our parish community continues to live out the call to be *a people for others*, following the example and spirituality of our patron, St. Ignatius of Loyola. In these weeks, we see how Ignatian principles of prayer, discernment, and service take shape in the lives of our young people and in the spirit of our parish life. It fills me with deep gratitude and joy to witness this movement of the Holy Spirit among us.

This week marks one of the most joyful and hope-filled weeks of our summer: Children's Choir Camp. Throughout the week, the halls of our parish are alive with the voices of children and the harmonies of sacred music. You may wonder why we offer such a camp, and the answer is deeply rooted in our Catholic understanding of worship and formation. Music is not merely an embellishment to our liturgy—it is a vital expression of the beauty, mystery, and transcendence of God. As St. Augustine reminds us, "*He who sings prays twice.*" By teaching our children the gift of sacred music, we are forming their hearts in worship, their minds in discipline, and their spirits in joy. The theme for this year's choir camp is "Sing a New Song to the Lord!"—a call taken from Psalm 98 that invites us to praise God in every season of our lives. Our campers will spend the week learning hymns and liturgical songs, rehearsing choral techniques, and exploring the meaning of the Mass. These are not simply music lessons — they are lessons in prayer, participation, and parish belonging. Their enthusiasm and energy are contagious, and I invite all parishioners to come and be uplifted at their musical performance on Friday evening, August 1st, at 7:00 PM in the church. Let us show our support and encourage these young disciples who are learning to glorify God with their voices. Then, on Sunday, August 3rd, at the 10:00 AM Mass, the children will lead us in song during our Holy Mass as we celebrate and honor our patron saint, St. Ignatius of Loyola. What better way to honor our patron than by witnessing the fruits of formation, joy, and service expressed through our youngest voices!

While our younger children prepare to form their hearts through song, our high school youth have been actively participating in the spiritual life of the parish and the wider Archdiocese. This weekend, many of our teens attended the Archdiocesan Youth Conference (AYC), an annual event that draws youth and their adult leaders from all corners of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston. AYC is the largest evangelizing gathering for high school youth in our local Church, and our teens joined thousands of others in proclaiming Christ, forming community, and discerning their faith journey. At AYC, our youth encountered the diversity and vibrancy of the Church. They participated in dynamic keynote presentations, interactive workshops on relevant faith topics, and powerful moments of sacramental grace through Mass, Adoration, and Reconciliation. These are not simply "fun events"—they are transformative experiences rooted in the encounter with Jesus Christ. As their pastor, I am deeply proud of the way our youth represent our parish and embrace the opportunity to grow as missionary disciples. Thank you to the chaperones and formation staff who accompanied them, walking beside them as companions on the journey, as St. Ignatius himself did with the first companions of the Society of Jesus.

Looking ahead, next weekend we will celebrate the Solemnity of St. Ignatius of Loyola, our parish's patronal feast. While the universal Church celebrates this feast on July 31st, we, like many parishes, move our celebration to the nearest Sunday so that the entire community can rejoice together. According to the liturgical norms of the Church, a patronal feast may be observed as a solemnity within the parish, and so we will mark this day with festive liturgy, sacred music, and a renewed commitment to living the Ignatian vision. St. Ignatius offers us a model of holiness that is dynamic, reflective, and apostolic. His spirituality urges us to find God in all things, to live with deep gratitude, and to discern how best to serve the Lord with our lives. He teaches us that prayer and action are not opposites, but two wings of the same call to discipleship. As we celebrate his feast, may we recommit ourselves to being a parish of missionary disciples—men, women, and children who, grounded in prayer, move outward in service and love. This is not just a celebration of a historical figure. It is a celebration of who we are as a parish—rooted in Ignatian spirituality, animated by the Eucharist, and united in our call to be *a people for others*. Whether you are new to our parish or have called St. Ignatius your home for many years, I invite you to enter more deeply into this identity. Join us for the feast, attend the Choir Camp Mass, pray with us, sing with us, and serve with us. Let us give thanks to God for the many blessings He has poured out upon our community. Let us rejoice in the voices of our children, the zeal of our youth, and the witness of St. Ignatius. And let us, with generous hearts, continue to labor for the greater glory of God.

Sunday, Jul 27, 2025**Celebrate our perfect parent**

In 1994 President Clinton signed a congressional resolution setting aside the fourth Sunday of July as Parents' Day for "recognizing, uplifting, and supporting the role of parents in the rearing of children." Embracing this day is easy for those of us who have or had loving parents, but for those of us who didn't experience great parenting, we may find it hard to feel uplifted. Surely, however, we can all celebrate the fact that we have a perfect divine parent who has loved us unconditionally and cared for us unceasingly since before we were born.

SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Genesis 18:20-32; Colossians 2:12-14; Luke 11:1-13 (111).

"If you . . . know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"

Monday, Jul 28, 2025**How does your garden grow?**

Jesus uses the parable of the mustard seed to illustrate that when the reign of God takes root even from the smallest seed, it will grow to great size. But is that what most of us want? Do we really hope to see the establishment of God's reign—where the lowly are lifted up and the mighty are brought to their knees? Scripture scholar John Dominic Crossan points out that in Mediterranean areas the mustard bushes that sprout from tiny mustard seeds are considered weeds—a nuisance to any garden. Hmm . . . how many of us find God's ways an irritant to our best-laid plans? God's reign is messy when judged by worldly standards. Weeds are welcome.

Exodus 32:15-24, 30-34; Matthew 13:31-35 (401). "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed . . . It becomes a large bush."

Tuesday, Jul 29, 2025**Martha has her moment**

Martha, Mary, and their brother Lazarus were close friends of Jesus. Martha has come down to us as the original "Type A" personality, the busy one in Luke's gospel who has trouble sitting still when Jesus visits. But she also was a woman of great courage and faith. Even in the face of her profound grief at having lost her brother, she was unshaken in her faith that Jesus was the "resurrection and the life." When a loss of a loved one leaves us feeling devastated, Martha's witness can bring strength and hope that death does not have the last word.

Wednesday, Jul 30, 2025**We are more precious than we know**

Jesus' metaphor that the kingdom of God is a "pearl of great price," so precious that a person would sell all their possessions to have it, may seem extreme. However, Jesus is not giving out financial advice. He is putting a fine point on a truth he has utter confidence in: that God and God's reign of love is all that matters. Often, it's only when we are

pushed to the brink and confronted with losing it all that we realize the "pearl" in our midst. Think about it. Jesus laid down his life for us. We are pearls of great price to him. Breathtaking, isn't it?

Exodus 34:29-35; Matthew 13:44-46 (403). "The Kingdom of heaven is like a merchant searching for fine pearls."

Thursday, Jul 31, 2025**Get in the spirit of giving**

The spirit of giving doesn't come naturally to all of us. Saint Ignatius, the founder of the Jesuits, had a prayer for that, as he did for most things: "Eternal Word, only begotten Son of God, teach me true generosity. Teach me to serve you as you deserve, to give without counting the cost, to fight heedless of wounds, to labor without seeking rest, to sacrifice myself without thought of any reward, save the knowledge that I have done your will." When the giving gets tough, the tough get on their knees and pray for wider hearts.

Friday, Aug 01, 2025**Anything not divine must go**

Skeptics abound. Those who retain their faith are tempted toward the fringes: a severe expression of religion that either lacks mercy or embraces a laxity that makes everything seem relative and even irrelevant. Does that sound like a description of our generation? Actually, it's how many described the 18th century that saw the rise of the Enlightenment but also severe economic inequalities and class divisions. In that divided age, Saint Alphonsus Liguori became the champion of a simple focus. "The heart of man will never find true peace, if it does not empty itself of all that is not God." In our own divisive age, that remains good advice.

Saturday, Aug 02, 2025**Fight against fear**

When word came to King Herod about Jesus and his ministry, Herod mistook him for John the Baptist come back from the dead. Perhaps Herod's error grew out of a fear that John had returned to haunt him or seek revenge of some kind for his murder at Herod's command. Fear can lead people to many kinds of misjudgments: avoiding problems, damaging relationships, not speaking out, holding back from taking steps to go forward in life. Muster the courage to fight your fear. This simple prayer to Jesus from 20th-century Trappist monk Thomas Merton may provide some strength: "I will not fear, for you are ever with me, and you will never leave me to face my perils alone."

first-come, first-served and, the
intention(s) of only one donor is allowed
per Mass.

is an option that allows our Priests to

celebrates a Mass, is off-campus,
while on pilgrimage, on retreat, etc.
You will not be notified of the date or
time of this Mass or be able to attend, but
your intentions will be offered as soon as

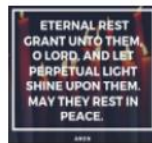

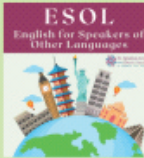

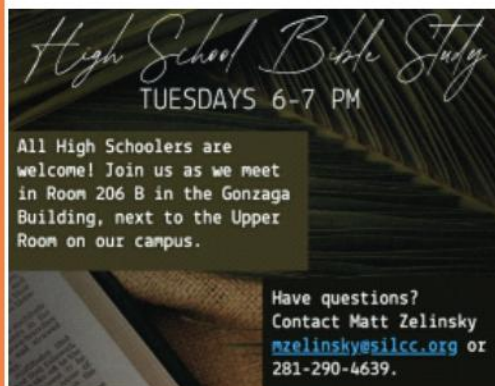

Queridos hermanos,

Al adentrarnos en pleno verano, nuestra comunidad parroquial continúa viviendo el llamado a ser *personas para los demás*, siguiendo el ejemplo y la espiritualidad de nuestro patrono, San Ignacio de Loyola. En estas semanas, vemos cómo los principios ignacianos de oración, discernimiento y servicio se concretan en la vida de nuestros jóvenes y en el espíritu de nuestra vida parroquial. Me llena de profunda gratitud y alegría presenciar esta manifestación del Espíritu Santo entre nosotros.

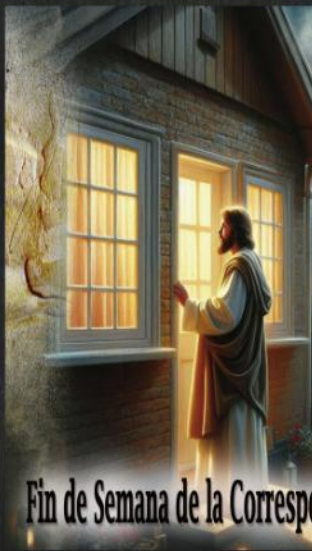
Esta semana marca una de las semanas más alegres y esperanzadoras de nuestro verano: el Campamento de Coro Infantil. A lo largo de la semana, los salones de nuestra parroquia se llenan de vida con las voces de los niños y las armonías de la música sacra. Quizás se pregunten por qué ofrecemos este campamento, y la respuesta está profundamente arraigada en nuestra comprensión católica del culto y la formación. La música no es simplemente un adorno para nuestra liturgia; es una expresión vital de la belleza, el misterio y la trascendencia de Dios. Como nos recuerda San Agustín: *«El que canta, ora dos veces»*. Al enseñar a nuestros niños el don de la música sacra, formamos sus corazones en la adoración, sus mentes en la disciplina y sus espíritus en la alegría. El tema del campamento de coro de este año es «¡Cantad al Señor un cántico nuevo!», un llamado tomado del Salmo 98 que nos invita a alabar a Dios en cada etapa de nuestra vida. Nuestros campistas pasarán la semana aprendiendo himnos y canciones litúrgicas, ensayando técnicas corales y explorando el significado de la Misa. Estas no son simplemente lecciones de música. Son lecciones de oración, participación y pertenencia parroquial. Su entusiasmo y energía son contagiosos, e invito a todos los feligreses a asistir y animarse con su presentación musical el viernes 1 de agosto a las 7:00 p.m. en la iglesia. Demostremos nuestro apoyo y animemos a estos jóvenes discípulos que están aprendiendo a glorificar a Dios con sus voces. Luego, el domingo 3 de agosto, en la misa de las 10:00 a.m., los niños nos guiarán en canto durante la Santa Misa para celebrar y honrar a nuestro santo patrón, San Ignacio de Loyola. ¡Qué mejor manera de honrar a nuestro patrón que presenciando los frutos de la formación, la alegría y el servicio expresados a través de las voces de nuestros más pequeños!

Mientras nuestros niños más pequeños se preparan para formar sus corazones a través del canto, nuestros jóvenes de preparatoria han estado participando activamente en la vida espiritual de la parroquia y de la Arquidiócesis en general. Este fin de semana, muchos de nuestros adolescentes asistieron a la Conferencia Arquidiocesana de Jóvenes (AYC), un evento anual que atrae a jóvenes y a sus líderes adultos de todos los rincones de la Arquidiócesis de Galveston-Houston. AYC es la reunión evangelizadora más grande para jóvenes de preparatoria en nuestra Iglesia local, y nuestros adolescentes se unieron a miles de personas para proclamar a Cristo, formar comunidad y discernir su camino de fe. En AYC, nuestros jóvenes experimentaron la diversidad y la vitalidad de la Iglesia. Participaron en presentaciones magistrales dinámicas, talleres interactivos sobre temas relevantes de fe y momentos impactantes de gracia sacramental a través de la Misa, la Adoración y la Reconciliación. Estos no son simplemente "eventos divertidos", sino experiencias transformadoras arraigadas en el encuentro con Jesucristo. Como su párroco, estoy profundamente orgulloso de la forma en que nuestros jóvenes representan a nuestra parroquia y aprovechan la oportunidad de crecer como discípulos misioneros. Gracias a los acompañantes y formadores que les acompañaron, caminando junto a ellos como compañeros de camino, como lo hizo el mismo San Ignacio con los primeros compañeros de la Compañía de Jesús.

De cara al futuro, el próximo fin de semana celebraremos la Solemnidad de San Ignacio de Loyola, la fiesta patronal de nuestra parroquia. Si bien la Iglesia universal celebra esta festividad el 31 de julio, nosotros, al igual que muchas parroquias, trasladamos nuestra celebración al domingo más cercano para que toda la comunidad pueda disfrutar junta. Según las normas litúrgicas de la Iglesia, una fiesta patronal puede celebrarse como solemnidad dentro de la parroquia, por lo que conmemoraremos este día con liturgia festiva, música sacra y un renovado compromiso de vivir la visión ignaciana. 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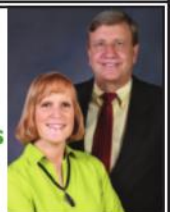
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
