





PASTOR'S COLUMN

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As we enjoy this Labor Day weekend, I first want to extend my sincere gratitude to all who sent cards, prayers, and kind wishes for my 71st birthday. God is good—always—and I am filled with thanksgiving for the gift of continued health and the privilege of remaining in active ministry. Each year is a reminder that life is a grace, and every breath, a call to continue serving the Lord and His people with joy, humility, and fidelity. Thank you for walking with me in this journey of faith.



I also want to express heartfelt thanks to all of you who participated in our recent Stewardship Weekend. It was inspiring to see so many of our parishioners—our missionary disciples—sharing their time and talents in the service of others. Your enthusiasm, generosity, and willingness to step forward in discipleship is the heartbeat of our parish. You truly embody the Ignatian principle of being “*men and women for others*.” If you were not able to attend the fair, please know that the invitation remains open. God has entrusted each of us with spiritual gifts, and your presence and participation are needed. The work of the Gospel is not confined to a weekend event, but is a *way of life*—a daily offering of ourselves in love and service. As St. Ignatius taught, we are to ask in prayerful discernment, “*What more can I do for Christ?*” If you have not yet found your place in ministry, I invite you to consider where your gifts might serve the mission of our parish—building a community of true accompaniment and becoming more fully “a people for others.”

As we turn the corner into September, our formation programs for the year are about to begin. Registration is now open for all age levels, and I urge you to make this a priority for your family. But let me emphasize something crucial: formation does not end with childhood or Confirmation. It begins—and continues—with adult formation. The *National Directory for Catechesis* reminds us that “*adult faith formation, by which people consciously grow in the life of Christ through experience, reflection, prayer, and study, must be the central task in the catechetical enterprise*” (*NDC*, no. 48). Formation is not merely about filling our heads with knowledge—it is about deepening our relationship with Christ and being transformed by Him, so we can live out our baptismal call as missionary disciples. As followers of Ignatian spirituality, we understand that God meets us in our lived experience. Through prayerful reflection—what Ignatius called the *Examen*—we see how God is forming us, teaching us, and inviting us to grow. In that light, formation is not a program we attend—it is a habit of the heart, a way of listening, learning, and loving more deeply in response to God’s ongoing revelation. Please take time this week to visit our parish website or review the bulletin, where you’ll find details about our formation offerings. Our dedicated formation staff is here to accompany you in discerning the best path forward—whether for yourself or your children. Don’t let this moment pass by. Let this be the year you commit more intentionally to deepening your faith.

As we mark Labor Day, it is worth reflecting on its deeper meaning from a Catholic perspective. This holiday is more than just a break from work or the unofficial end of summer—it is an opportunity to reaffirm the dignity and sanctity of human labor. In *Rerum Novarum*, Pope Leo XIII reminds us that “*work is not a mere commodity*,” but an expression of human dignity and a participation in God’s ongoing creation. St. John Paul II, in his encyclical *Laborem Exercens*, expands on this, teaching that “*man is the image of God partly through the mandate received from his Creator to subdue, to dominate, the earth... and especially through his work*.” Our labor—be it in the home, the field, the classroom, the office, or the sanctuary—is not merely economic activity. It is a means of cooperating with God’s will, sustaining human life, and building up the common good. As a parish committed to Ignatian spirituality, we recognize that even the most ordinary tasks—when done with love and purpose—can be a form of prayer. As St. Ignatius would counsel: “*Ad majorem Dei gloriam*”—*All for the greater glory of God*. May we carry this mindset into our work, not just this weekend, but every day.

Finally, a word of thanks for supporting our youth ministry this summer through the paleta sales. This weekend marks the final round of sales, and we are grateful for your generous participation. Each paleta you purchased not only helped cool you down during these hot summer days, but also supported the faith formation, service experiences, and evangelization efforts of our young people. Thank you for believing in them and in the mission of forming the next generation of missionary disciples.

As we move into this new season, may we remain faithful to the graces God places before us: opportunities for service, growth, prayer, and love. I am truly blessed to walk with you as your pastor, and I remain inspired by your generosity, your witness, and your hunger for God. Let us continue to ask, in true Ignatian spirit: “*Lord, what do you want me to do for your greater glory?*” And then, with courage and joy, let us go and do it.

Gifts that keep on giving

"Love one another." "Forgive everyone." "Give to those who cannot repay you." These sayings of Jesus seem like a lot of hard work with little reward. But nothing could be further from the truth. Have you ever left a large tip for a tired waitress or waiter? Or smiled at a store clerk who was having a difficult day? Such gestures generate feelings of gratitude and well-being that do not come any other way. If we spent only a few minutes every day thinking of a small gift we could give to someone, just imagine how our world would change! Try it today—then do it again tomorrow.

Prophetic advice

When Jesus returned to Nazareth and spoke prophetically, his hometown people rejected him. That foreshadowed the reception he would receive from his own people in general. It is a pattern repeated many times in history, from the time of the Jewish prophets who suffered repudiation right through to our own era, when right-to-life and immigrant-rights activists encounter stiff resistance to their prophetic message. It does us well to give folks a second hearing if we find ourselves made uncomfortable by their message. It may be the one we need to hear most. Pope Francis called each of us to be a prophet, who "shows Jesus to others, witnesses him, and helps live today and build tomorrow according to Jesus' design."

Our small efforts make a splash

What does encouragement look like? A smile, a pat on the back, a kind word, an affirmation of effort or accomplishment. Encouragement is not hard physical labor. Yet at times we find it difficult to overcome our anger or disappointment in how little impact we've had. But Servant of God Dorothy Day says, "No one has a right to sit down and feel hopeless. There's too much work to do." Her words of encouragement can help us encourage others. "What is the sense of our small effort?" Day asks. "A pebble cast into a pond causes ripples that spread in all directions. Each one of our thoughts, words, and deeds is like that."

The cure for what ails you

"I will not fear, for you are ever with me, and you will never leave me to face my perils alone." This hopeful prayer of Thomas Merton is one to draw on in difficult times. Hope is exactly what we need when we are in pain or despair. It is the foundation of all healing. Our bodies, minds, and hearts are made for healing. That healing may come quickly and

completely, or it may be long, painful, and only partially realized. And for each of us, once in a lifetime, healing ends in death. Yet as Christians, we remain hopeful because we have been promised the forgiveness of sins and eternal life in God's love. So draw on hope—and let the healing begin.

Our happiness is God's

The biblical scholar Father Jerome Neyrey, S.J. wonders of the Early Church: "What it must have been like to be catechized into the gospel of Jesus, told that in Baptism we die with him and rise with him." It was a radically new message—yet it remains so. What does it mean to find new life in death? Why do we and how can we feel the presence of the risen Christ? These questions continue to astound and fascinate us. Not to worry if we cannot fathom the depths of the mystery. As Saint Rose Philippine Duchesne says, "We may not understand His Will for us in time, but in eternity the veil will be drawn and we shall see that He acted only for our happiness."

Celebrate good times

From the moment you hit the reception hall until the happy couple drives away, tin cans rattling and tissue-paper flowers fluttering, it's party time. Hors d'oeuvres piled high on plates make the rounds, and sparkling beverages are liberally poured. The food never stops coming, from the first salad to the final slice of much-decorated cake. Music fills the hall and dancers demonstrate how each generation once cut the rug. Cameras capture the joy of the hour with each flash. That is what celebration looks like. Jesus says every hour is worth celebrating, for those who believe. It's time to party!

Some rules are meant to be broken

Jesus condemns strict observance of the sabbath when it comes at the expense of life and well-being. Who wouldn't want to recover an animal that fell down a well on the sabbath or gather grain to feed one's family? In today's terms, you'd search for your lost pet on a Sunday or go grocery shopping if you were out of food. Jesus loves the law and understands its value, but he wants to make a larger point about how God's love comes ahead of strict observances. Simply put, in the words of Saint Thérèse of Lisieux, "Without love, deeds, even the most brilliant, count as nothing." Show some kindness ahead of everything else, and you'll make a sabbath of your life each day.







Queridos hermanos,

Mientras disfrutamos de este fin de semana y celebramos el Día del Trabajo, quiero expresar mi sincera gratitud a todos los que me enviaron tarjetas, oraciones y buenos deseos por mi 71.^º cumpleaños. Dios es bueno, siempre, y estoy lleno de agradecimiento por el don de la salud y el privilegio de seguir en el ministerio activo. Cada año es un recordatorio de que la vida es una gracia, y cada respiro, un llamado a seguir sirviendo al Señor y a su pueblo con alegría, humildad y fidelidad. Gracias por acompañarme en este camino de fe.



También quiero expresar mi más sincero agradecimiento a todos los que participaron en nuestro reciente Fin de Semana de la Corresponsabilidad. Fue inspirador ver a tantos feligreses —nuestros discípulos misioneros— compartir su tiempo y talentos al servicio de los demás. Su entusiasmo, generosidad y disposición para dar un paso al frente en el discipulado son el latido de nuestra parroquia. Ustedes verdaderamente encarnan el principio ignaciano de ser "*hombres y mujeres para los demás*". Si no pudieron asistir a la feria, sepan que la invitación sigue abierta. Dios nos ha confiado dones espirituales a cada uno, y su presencia y participación son necesarias. La obra del Evangelio no se limita a un evento de fin de semana, sino que es *una forma de vida*: una ofrenda diaria de nosotros mismos en amor y servicio. Como enseñó San Ignacio, debemos preguntarnos en oración y discernimiento: "¿Qué más puedo hacer por Cristo?". Si aún no han encontrado su lugar en el ministerio, los invito a considerar cómo sus dones podrían contribuir a la misión de nuestra parroquia: construyendo una comunidad de verdadero acompañamiento y convirtiéndonos más plenamente en "*un pueblo para los demás*".

Con la llegada de septiembre, nuestros programas de formación están a punto de comenzar para este año. La inscripción ya está abierta para todas las edades, y les animo a que le den prioridad a esto para su familia. Pero permítanme enfatizar algo crucial: la formación no termina con la infancia ni con la Confirmación. Comienza, y continúa, con la formación adulta. *El Directorio Nacional para la Catequesis* nos recuerda que «*la formación en la fe adulta, mediante la cual las personas crecen conscientemente en la vida de Cristo a través de la experiencia, la reflexión, la oración y el estudio, debe ser la tarea central de la labor catequética*» (NDC, n.º 48). La formación no se trata simplemente de llenarnos la cabeza de conocimiento, sino de profundizar nuestra relación con Cristo y ser transformados por Él, para que podamos vivir nuestro llamado bautismal como discípulos misioneros. Como seguidores de la espiritualidad ignaciana, entendemos que Dios nos encuentra en nuestra experiencia vivida. A través de la reflexión orante —lo que Ignacio llamó el Examen— vemos cómo Dios nos forma, nos enseña y nos invita a crecer. Desde esa perspectiva, la formación no es un programa al que asistimos, sino un hábito del corazón, una forma de escuchar, aprender y amar más profundamente en respuesta a la revelación continua de Dios. Por favor, dediquen tiempo esta semana al visitar el sitio web de nuestra parroquia o al chequear el boletín, donde encontrarán detalles sobre nuestros programas de formación. Nuestro dedicado equipo de formación está aquí para acompañarlos en el discernimiento del mejor camino a seguir, ya sea para ustedes o para sus hijos. No dejen pasar este momento. Que este sea el año en que se comprometan con mayor intención a profundizar su fe.

Al conmemorar el Día del Trabajo, vale la pena reflexionar sobre su significado más profundo desde una perspectiva católica. Esta festividad es más que un simple descanso del trabajo o el fin no oficial del verano: es una oportunidad para reafirmar la dignidad y la santidad del trabajo humano. En la *Rerum Novarum*, el Papa León XIII nos recuerda que «*el trabajo no es una mera mercancía*», sino una expresión de la dignidad humana y una participación en la creación continua de Dios. San Juan Pablo II, en su encíclica *Laborem Exercens*, amplía este concepto, enseñando que «*el hombre es imagen de Dios, en parte, por el mandato recibido de su Creador de someter y dominar la tierra... y especialmente por su trabajo*». Nuestro trabajo —ya sea en el hogar, el campo, el aula, la oficina o el santuario— no es una mera actividad económica. Es un medio para cooperar con la voluntad de Dios, sustentar la vida humana y construir el bien común.
