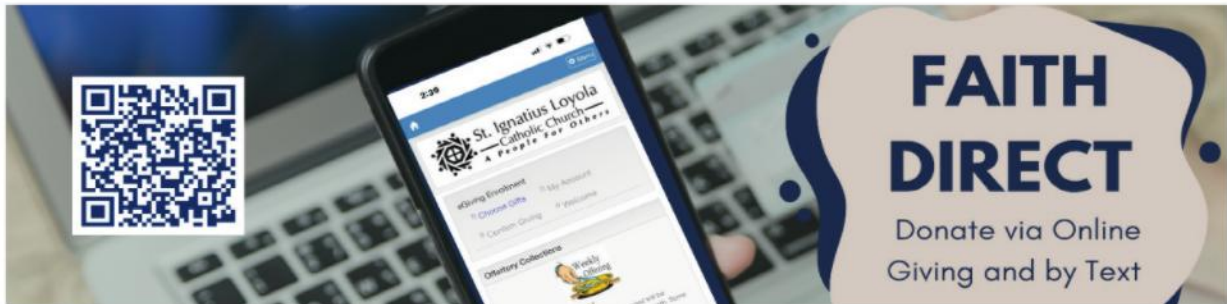

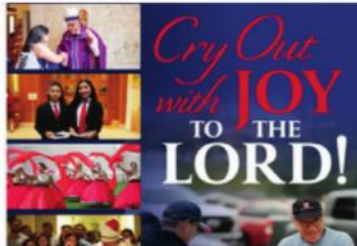

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This weekend we welcome home the men who participated in our parish's 14th ACTS Retreat. To you, my brothers, I say: *Welcome home!* What a gift your "yes" to the Lord has been, not only for yourselves, but also for your families and our parish. On retreat, you encountered the living God—in prayer, in the sacraments, in fellowship, and in silence. But the retreat does not end when you return home. The flame that was ignited in your hearts must be carried forward. Keep the fire burning! Share it in your families, your workplaces, and here in our parish community. The ACTS retreat is not only a personal encounter with Christ but also a call to become an instrument of accompaniment. The more you witness to your faith, the more other men will be drawn into this life-changing encounter with Christ. Thank you for your courage and your openness; may your "yes" echo in the lives of others.

September always feels like a month of new beginnings, and this year is no exception. Our formation classes are now underway, and with them comes a special time in the lives of many of our children, youth, and families. For some, this year will bring the grace of the Sacrament of Reconciliation; for others, the joy of receiving the Holy Eucharist for the first time; and for still others, the strengthening power of Confirmation. At the same time, our OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) sessions have begun. You may still be accustomed to hearing the term RCIA, but the shift from "R" (Rite) to "O" (Order) is a profound reminder. Becoming Catholic is not a single ritual moment; it is a series of sacred steps, celebrated in order, that lead a person ever deeper into the mystery of Christ and into communion with His Church. To speak of it as "Becoming Catholic" is really the most accurate way. This process is never a solitary one. Just as the early disciples walked together, so too do we accompany these new brothers and sisters on their journey of faith. And this is where our call to be missionary disciples comes alive. Each of us—by our prayer, our example, our words, and our presence—helps to form others in faith. We cannot overstate this truth: discipleship is not a private journey. It is always a pilgrimage we walk together, as Church, as community, as the Body of Christ.

In recent weeks, a group of parishioners returned from pilgrimage to Medjugorje. Deeply moved by their encounter with Our Lady's call to conversion and peace, they are beginning a new parish prayer group. Their format is simple but powerful: reflection on Mary's messages, the Rosary, prayer to St. Michael the Archangel, a short Gospel reflection, a prayer of spiritual communion, and petitions. The beauty of this group is that it lasts only 30 minutes and is conducted entirely by phone. Every Wednesday morning from 6:45–7:15 a.m., you can dial in—whether from your kitchen table, your office, or even while commuting to work—and join your fellow parishioners in prayer. What a beautiful way to begin the day! I encourage you to read more details in the bulletin and consider joining this effort to anchor our parish life more deeply in prayer and intercession.

As you know, we are now entering our third month without a parochial vicar. Many of you have asked and prayed for the arrival of our newly assigned priest, and I want to share with you where things stand. The holdup lies not with the archdiocese, but with immigration and the R-1 visa process. What was once a fairly routine step has now become burdensome and unpredictable. Imagine being asked by immigration authorities to explain what a priest does for work! While some might mistakenly think our life is only about Sunday Mass and reading Scripture during the week, you and I know otherwise. From appointments, counseling, anointing the sick, visiting families in crisis, presiding at weddings and funerals, walking with those in formation, and the countless daily tasks of shepherding a parish of our size—this is work only made possible through grace, and it is certainly *full-time*. I share this not to complain, but to invite your continued prayers and patience. We have not been forgotten by the archdiocese. They remain committed to assigning us a parochial vicar. For now, we wait together, and in the meantime I am grateful for your support, your understanding, and your willingness to walk with me in this season of waiting.

Brothers and sisters, our parish is alive with grace. ACTS retreats are rekindling faith. Formation is nurturing the next generation of disciples. OCIA is opening the doors of the Church to new members. Prayer groups are anchoring us in devotion to Our Lady and to Christ. Even the challenge of waiting for a new priest becomes an invitation to grow in patience and trust. Let us remember: we do not walk this journey alone. In the words of St. Paul, "*We, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually parts of one another*" (Romans 12:5). May we continue to walk together, as missionary disciples, as a parish community, and as a people for others.

With gratitude for each of you, and entrusting our parish to the loving intercession of St. Ignatius of Loyola,

WEEK READINGS

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Sunday, Sep 07, 2025**Don't hold back**

Do we recognize the Jesus who says, "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, he cannot be my disciple"? The words seem harsh in comparison to the soothing invitation of the Good Shepherd. Not to worry—Jesus is not insisting we abandon family or become homeless in order to follow him. But Jesus is saying, without doubt, that nothing—no thing and no one—can become so central in life that it interferes with doing God's will to love God and love your neighbor as yourself by being just, showing mercy, and walking with God. Jesus' call is "do as I do. Love as I love, hold nothing back. Do this in remembrance of me."

Monday, Sep 08, 2025**Set your sights on love**

Disappointments come in all varieties: in finance, romance, parenting, and professional fulfillment. Some of us dream big dreams only to reap what seem humble returns. Should we set our sights lower, then, to keep disappointment at bay? For his part Saint Paul does recommend an attitude adjustment: Aim for love. Those who orient their actions and intentions toward love of God will not be disappointed because God is glad to employ all things, successes and failures together, to fulfill divine purposes. Just ask Saints Joachim and Anne, aged parents of a late-arriving child soon to be called "full of grace."

Tuesday, Sep 09, 2025**The secret lives of Christians**

The Spanish Jesuit priest Saint Peter Claver spent 40 years ministering to African slaves arriving in the port of Cartagena, in what is now Colombia. Many thought he was wasting his time and even opposed his work with people whose welfare was almost entirely neglected. In the last few years of his life, Peter himself was nearly forgotten, having become ill and confined to his room. Yet his death in 1654 prodded the city into the realization they had lost a saint. Even if your efforts to help others go unnoticed or unappreciated—the beneficiaries of your goodwill will know you through your works as will God.

Wednesday, Sep 10, 2025**Take a good hard look**

What's not to love about the Beatitudes? Each is a source of hope in the midst of the joys and sorrows of everyday life. But then there's that curious part that follows that begins with those fateful words, "Woe to you," and that's about the time we decide God is taking on all those "evildoers" out there. It's difficult to hear these words of admonishment addressed to us,

yet we must take them to heart and see them as calling us to life. Joan of Arc offers a good prayer for these moments of uncertainty: "If I am in God's grace, may he keep me there. If I am not, may he put me there."

Colossians 3:1-11; Luke 6:20-26 (439). "You have taken off the old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed."

Thursday, Sep 11, 2025**You are what you wear**

Clothing has a dual purpose: to protect the body from harsh weather and to adorn and identify ourselves: the business suit of an executive, the jeans of a teenager, the uniform of a soldier. In that respect, it makes sense that Saint Paul says we should "put on" virtue; we should wear compassion, kindness, patience, gentleness as colorfully and obviously as we wear our outfits. Paul wants us to wear our allegiance to Christ "on our sleeves" if you will. The Christian display is not meant as a boast like a Gucci or Prada logo, but as a simple, humble sign that the wearer belongs to Christ, and is thus cloaked in love.

Colossians 3:12-17; Luke 6:27-38 (440). "Over all these put on love."

Friday, Sep 12, 2025**Set a good example**

Remember that moment when you first realized: "Oh, my gosh, I'm becoming my mother!"—or your father or whoever it was staring back at you from the mirror of your life? We do tend to grow up to become like our elders in many ways, whether we like it or not. Indeed, we put a lot of time and effort into trying to mold young people. Yet, if the above is true, we ought to spend more energy molding and shaping ourselves to be worthy of emulation. That way, when the student becomes like the teacher, we will have made some progress. Remember, says Pope Benedict XVI, "a witness of Christ does not merely transmit information but, through the coherency of his own life, becomes a dependable reference point."

1 Timothy 1:1-2, 12-14; Luke 6:39-42 (441). "No disciple is superior to the teacher; but when fully trained, every disciple will be like his teacher."

Saturday, Sep 13, 2025**Simple words of wisdom**

A gifted preacher gains a great following. Take the Early Church Father John Chrysostom (347-407) for example. Because of his eloquence, he was given the surname chrysostomos, meaning "golden mouthed," and his sermons are still studied and quoted today. What gave his words such power? It is said he avoided flowery language and complex images; instead, he spoke simply and plainly and applied biblical lessons to everyday life. Here's one sweet example: "The bee is more honored than other animals, not because she labors, but because she labors for others." Gifted preaching changes hearts and lives. The next time you hear such preaching, let the one who delivered it know you appreciate the effort that went into preparing it.

Queridos hermanos,

Este fin de semana le damos la bienvenida a casa a los hombres que participaron en el 14.º Retiro de ACTS en nuestra parroquia. A ustedes, hermanos, les digo: ¡Bienvenidos a casa! ¡Qué gran regalo ha sido su "sí" al Señor, no solo para ustedes, sino también para sus familias y nuestra parroquia! En el retiro, encontraron al Dios vivo en la oración, en los sacramentos, en la comunión y en el silencio. Pero el retiro no termina al regresar a casa. La llama que se encendió en sus corazones debe continuar. ¡Mantengan viva la llama! Compártanla en sus familias, en sus lugares de trabajo y aquí en nuestra comunidad parroquial. El retiro ACTS no es solo un encuentro personal con Cristo, sino también un llamado a ser un instrumento de acompañamiento. Cuanto más den testimonio de su fe, más otros hombres se sentirán atraídos a este encuentro transformador con Cristo. Gracias por su valentía y su apertura; que su "sí" resuene en la vida de los demás. Septiembre siempre se siente como un mes de nuevos comienzos, y este año no es la excepción. Nuestras clases de formación ya están en marcha, y con ellas llega un momento especial en la vida de muchos de nuestros niños, jóvenes y familias. Para algunos, este año traerá la gracia del Sacramento de la Reconciliación; para otros, la alegría de recibir la Sagrada Eucaristía por primera vez; y para otros, el poder fortalecedor de la Confirmación. Al mismo tiempo, han comenzado nuestras sesiones de OCIA (Orden de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos). Quizás todavía estén acostumbrados a escuchar el término RICA, pero el cambio de "R" (Rito) a "O" (Orden) es un profundo recordatorio. Convertirse católico no es un solo momento ritual; es una serie de pasos sagrados, celebrados en orden, que llevan a la persona a una inmersión cada vez más profunda en el misterio de Cristo y a la comunión con su Iglesia. Hablar de ello como "Convertirse en católico" es realmente la forma más precisa. Este proceso nunca es solitario. Así como los primeros discípulos caminaron juntos, también acompañamos a estos nuevos hermanos y hermanas en su camino de fe. Y aquí es donde cobra vida nuestro llamado a ser discípulos misioneros. Cada uno de nosotros —con nuestra oración, nuestro ejemplo, nuestras palabras y nuestra presencia— ayuda a formar a otros en la fe. No podemos exagerar esta verdad: el discipulado no es un camino privado. Es siempre una peregrinación que recorremos juntos, como Iglesia, como comunidad, como Cuerpo de Cristo.

Hace unas semanas, un grupo de feligreses regresó de su peregrinación a Medjugorje. Profundamente conmovidos por su encuentro con la llamada de Nuestra Señora a la conversión y la paz, están iniciando un nuevo grupo de oración parroquial. Su formato es sencillo pero conmovedor: reflexión sobre los mensajes de María, el Rosario, oración a San Miguel Arcángel, una breve reflexión del Evangelio, una oración de comunión espiritual y peticiones. Lo mejor de este grupo es que dura solo 30 minutos y se realiza completamente por teléfono. Todos los miércoles por la mañana, de 6:45 a 7:15 a.m., pueden llamar, ya sea desde la mesa de su cocina, su oficina o incluso de camino al trabajo, y unirse a sus compañeros feligreses en oración. ¡Qué hermosa manera de comenzar el día! Los animo a leer más detalles en el boletín y a considerar unirse a este esfuerzo para arraigar nuestra vida parroquial más profundamente en la oración y la intercesión.

Como saben, estamos entrando en nuestro tercer mes sin vicario parroquial. Muchos de ustedes han pedido y orado por la llegada de nuestro nuevo sacerdote, y quiero compartir con ustedes la situación actual. El problema no reside en la arquidiócesis, sino en inmigración y el proceso de la visa R-1. Lo que antes era un trámite bastante rutinario ahora se ha vuelto arduo e impredecible. ¡Imagínense que las autoridades de inmigración les pidieran que explicaran a qué se dedica un sacerdote! Aunque algunos podrían pensar erróneamente que nuestra vida se centra únicamente en la misa dominical y la lectura de las Escrituras entre semana, ustedes y yo sabemos lo contrario. Desde las citas, la consejería, la unción de enfermos, las visitas a familias en crisis, la celebración de bodas y funerales, el acompañamiento a los que se están formando y las innumerables tareas diarias de pastorear una parroquia de nuestro tamaño, este es un trabajo que solo es posible gracias a la gracia de Dios, y sin duda es *de tiempo completo*. Comparto esto no para quejarme, sino para invitarlos a seguir orando y teniendo paciencia. La arquidiócesis no nos ha olvidado. Mantiene su compromiso de asignarnos un vicario parroquial. Por ahora, esperamos juntos, y mientras tanto, les agradezco su apoyo, su comprensión y su disposición a acompañarme en esta espera.

Hermanos, nuestra parroquia está llena de vida y de la gracia del Señor. Los retiros de ACTS reavivan la fe. La formación nutre a la próxima generación de discípulos. OCIA abre las puertas de la Iglesia a nuevos miembros. Los grupos de oración nos fortalecen en la devoción a Nuestra Señora y a Cristo. Incluso el desafío de esperar a un nuevo sacerdote se convierte en una invitación a crecer en paciencia y confianza. Recordemos: no recorreremos este camino solos. En palabras de San Pablo: «*Siendo muchos, formamos un solo Cuerpo en Cristo y en lo que respecta a cada uno, somos miembros los unos de los otros.*» (Romanos 12,5). Que sigamos caminando juntos, como discípulos misioneros, como comunidad parroquial y como personas para los demás.

No te contengas

¿Reconocemos al Jesús que dice, “Si alguien viene a mí sin odiar a su padre y a su madre, esposa e hijos, él no puede ser mi discípulo”? Las palabras parecen duras en comparación con la invitación calmante del Buen Pastor. 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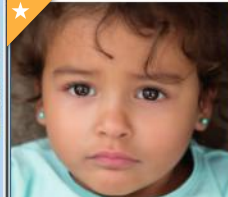
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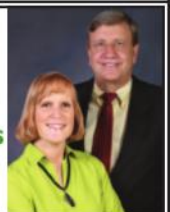


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
