ABOUT THE CEBL

CANADIAN ELITE BASKETBALL LEAGUE

A league created by Canadians for Canadians with a mission to develop Canadian players, coaches, sports executives, and referees, the CEBL boasts the highest percentage of Canadian players of any pro league in the country with 75% of its rosters being Canadian and a record 10 players with NBA experience in 2024.

Players also bring experience from the NBA G League, top international pro leagues, the Canadian National team program, NCAA programs, as well as U SPORTS and CCAA. 17 players have signed NBA contracts following a CEBL season, and numerous CEBL players attend NBA G League training camps every year.

We are a nation of passionate sports fans. It makes us proud, and ultimately it defines who we are. We are bringing together international pro basketball players with Canadian elite players to form a highly competitive professional basketball league.

The CEBL surpassed its own total attendance figures in 2023 with a 52 per cent increase from the previous season and nine out of 10 arenas experiencing at least two sold-out games. The CEBL plans to expand to a 14-16 team league that spreads from coast-to-coast over the next four years.



TRANSPORTATION & ARRIVAL

Teachers/schools are responsible for booking and organizing their own buses/transportation. The Calgary Surge will support school arrivals on-site with:

- Designated drop-off zones
- Supervised entry and secure group check-in
- Event staff support for school group intake
- Detailed arrival instructions, drop-off procedures, and entry timing will be shared with registered schools in advance.
