Behold Your God- 2

What view do you have of God? Where is it from?

- -All have formulated a concept of God in our minds.
- -What you have heard from others, you fabricated, God's Word.

Isa. 40:9-11

- -Get up on a high mountain & lift up your voice with strength & shout.
 - -Behold your God!
 - -"behold"- fix your eyes on, see w/ attention & care.
 - -"your"- shows personal, closeness.
- -Isaiah is writing to people in captivity- oppressed, dim future.
 - -America & christianity today.
 - -Enemy is gaining ground. Future is dim.

As we fix our eyes upon God we see...

I. Behold Your God is Strong (10)

- 1. Christ came first as a lamb to the slaughter. **Isa. 53:6-7**
 - -Gentle, quiet, allowing men to push around.
- 2. Christ is coming again in power & might. Rev. 19:11-21
 - -Too strong to be withstood, even all the power of hell.
 - -Coming to rule & reign as king. Phil. 2:9-11
- 3. In His strength He will execute the wrath of Almighty God.
 - -Rev. 19:15
 - *-What do you think about the wrath of God?*
 - -What about His love? How do you reconcile the 2?
 - -"Wrath"- God's holy & just anger or displeasure against sin. **Rom. 1:18**
 - -Sin must be punished.
 - -Will a loving God send people to hell? (Good Judge illustration)
 - -Condemned already- Jn. 3:16-18
 - -God must execute justice- must have J.C.

- 4. You cannot separate the wrath, justice, & love of God.
 - -Choose 1 quality & remove 1 you don't like creates an idol in your mind.
 - -Have to accept all attributes together- can't pick & choose.
- 5. "His reward" God will recompense to all according to their work.

 -Judgment Seat- White throne.
- 6 He came to do God's will

II. Behold Your God is Gentle (11)

- 1. The God of wrath is also a Gentle shepherd.
 - -Jesus Christ is referred to as:
 - -Shepherd & bishop of our souls. I Pet. 2:25
 - -Chief Shepherd. I Pet. 5:4
 - -The good shepherd. John 10:1-14
- 2. Job of a shepherd.
 - -Feed through God's Word.
 - -Care & lead the weak & young believers.
 - -Protect from the enemy.
- 3. Does it gently- softly, tenderly, w/o violence.
 - -Leads us hardhearted, heard headed, faithless sheep.

Conclusion

- -Contrast- Power & wrath of God w/ gentleness, love & compassion.
 - II Pet. 3:9 promise- wrath/ longsuffering- gentle
- -The wrath of God is just as real as the love of God.
 - -Can't remove either one.
 - -You must have Christ to remove the wrath of God-.
 - -Condemned already.
