# Obeying God Even When it Could Hurt- 4

#### Introduction

- -Daniel has graduated college and has been promoted to 2nd in command. He is working for the third king now.
- -Daniel's is a moral, honest, & hard-working man. He invests in his 'community. Surely every one would love someone like this?
- -In an increasing secular society, naturally there will come resistance & persecution to followers of Jesus.
- What do we do if laws or rules are put in place that prohibit us from practicing our faith?

## I. A Real Enemy (Dan. 6:4-9)

- 1. We have a real enemy that is against us.
  - -I Pet. 5:8, Eph. 6:11-12
  - -There will be some who want to tear down a honest hard working person.
    - -People will lie, deceive, and try to a believer's destroy testimony.
- 2. Daniel had such a strong life story that his enemies could not find a way to tear him down.
  - -What do they find in vs. 4? No skeletons or covered up lies. People should have to dig hard to find nothing.
- 3. They will not stop here but go to great lengths to trap Daniel.
  - -What is their plan?
    - -Could not pray to God or capital punishment.
    - -Can only trap him in his faithfulness to God!
  - -Why did they choose this particular plan?
    - -Knew he could not go without praying for 30 days.
- 4. Have any laws or rules been set up like this?

-For teachers & students in schools, government workers, & certain buildings,

### II. A Real Faith (Dan. 6:10-20)

- 1. As soon as Daniel hears about the law what does he do?
  - -Does he gripe, complain, or get angry?
  - -He went & prayed- He immediately disobeyed the law.
- 2. He prayed publicly & unashamedly.
  - -Open windows in a kneeling position three times a day.
  - -Why not closed windows, sitting w/o head bowed, and super early or late?
- 3. Was Daniel just being hard-headed or obstinate?
  - -No, "As he did aforetime" This is what Daniel did each day. Just another day. Who Daniel is.
  - -Enemy knew it & devised this specific plan.
- 4. What if someone asks you not to pray, read bible, talk about God, pray in Jesus name?
  - -When is it ok to go against a law or rule?
    - -Acts 5:17-21, 25-29 (What changed in Peter?)
    - -When that law/rule causes you to compromise what God has instructed us to do.
- 5. Daniel possessed a real faith & God remained first in his life.
  - -He was willing to face consequences.
  - -His faith is who he was and not something he did.

## III. A Real God (Dan. 6:21-28)

- 1. The king asks Daniel whether His God is real & able to save.
  - -Why did God protect Daniel? (vs. 22 & 23)
    - -He was innocent & believed God.
- 2. Justice is served on Daniel's enemies.(24)
  - -Rom. 12:19-21

3. Because Daniel stayed true & did not compromise, God used it in a mighty way to promote Daniel's faith. (25-28)-God was glorified!
