- -Chapter 40 all about "behold your God."
  - -Look, think, & meditate on who God is.
  - -Revealed in power, incomparable, judge, & creator.
- -Do you ever get weary/tired in life?
  - -Physically, spiritually, or emotionally?
  - -What you will do, be, marry, job, finances, house.

#### Isa. 40:28-31

## I. God Revealed (28)

- 1. The Everlasting God.
  - -Never created, always has been & always will be.
  - -No beginning or end-- no decay or change.
    - -I Am- always present.

### 2. The LORD.

- -Proper name of the God of Israel "Yaweh."
  - -Jews did not write out of respect.
- -Implies personal or covenant relationship.
  - -Pictures God as one who exists or causes existence.
- -How He revealed himself to Moses. Ex. 6:2
  - -The I AM of Ex. 3:14 & Rev. 11:17.

## 3. The Creator.

- -To create from nothing or reform existing material.
  - -Only God is the subject of this verb.
- -Creator of all thus rightful ruler of all.
- 4. He doesn't get tired or weary.
  - -Cannot be fully search out. Rom. 11:33-36

This Great God as just revealed gets personal with us.

## **II. God Reminds (29-30)**

1. He helps those who are weak and needy.

- 2. He reminds us that we will faint & grow weary in life.
  - -"Faint"- tire, fatigue, exhausted.
  - -"Fall"- to stumble, stagger.
- 3. He reminds us that even those with extra strength will tire.
  - -Life is hard & toilsome.
  - -School, work, spiritual decisions, marriage, finances, will of God, learning, & mistakes.

## III. He Renews (31)

- 1. God reveals who He is & reminds us of who we are.
  - -We will faint but He does not.
- 2. We must wait upon the Lord.
  - -By faith rely upon him & commit to His guidance.
- 3. Those who wait will renew their strength.
  - -"Renew"- renovate, restore, rebuild.
  - -To begin again- Life of new beginnings.
- 4. Mount up with wings as eagles.
  - -What doe eagles represent? Power, freedom, & strength.

#### Conclusion

- -Life will swallow us up. We will get weary, aggravated, & spiritually drained.
- -Conditional- "they that wait." Waiting is hard & we can be impatient.

- -You must have consistent periods in life when you wait upon God .
  - -Get alone with God, searching, reflecting, read, & pray.
  - -10 mins, 30 mins, day, week.
