At a regular session of said Board, held in the City of White Cloud, in said County, on the 8th day of July, 2026, the following Resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION #07-017-26

**AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION AND FINANCING OF A PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION
SYSTEM PURSUANT TO THE REVENUE BOND ACT, PUBLIC ACT 94 OF 1933,
AS AMENDED, MCL 141.101 *ET SEQ***

WHEREAS, Newaygo County (the "County") is a public corporation and political subdivision of the State of Michigan within the meaning of the Revenue Bond Act, Public Act 94 of 1933, as amended, MCL 141.101 *et seq.* ("Act 94"); and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the public health, safety, and welfare to purchase, acquire, construct, improve, enlarge, extend, or repair a public transportation system (the "Transportation System") to provide transportation services within or beyond its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, transportation systems are recognized as public improvements within the meaning of Act 94; and

WHEREAS, the County has historically owned, supported, or participated in the ownership of public transportation facilities, vehicles, and related assets serving County residents;

WHEREAS, the County may finance all or a portion of the Transportation System as permitted by Act 94 and other applicable law; and

WHEREAS, consistent with Act 94 and prior County practice, the County intends to operate the Transportation System as a County department, under direct supervision of the County Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to authorize the acquisition, construction and financing of the Transportation System and to take all actions necessary to effectuate the same.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the County Board of Commissioners of Newaygo County, Michigan, as follows:

1. The County hereby affirms its authority under Public Act 94 to acquire, own, improve, maintain, and finance a County Public Transportation System.

2. The County hereby determines that the acquisition, construction, improvement, equipping, and financing of a Public Transportation System constitutes a public improvement necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County.

3. The County is authorized to issue revenue bonds, notes or other indebtedness pursuant to Act 94, to finance all or a portion of the costs of the Transportation System, including design, acquisition, construction, equipping, operation and related costs.

4. Such bonds or obligations shall be payable solely from the revenue derived from the operation of the Transportation System or such other revenues as may be permitted by Act 94 and shall not constitute a general obligation of the County unless otherwise expressly approved.

5. The County is authorized to own and operate the Transportation System directly or pursuant to a contract with a third-party operator or transportation provider for management and operation subject to applicable law.

6. The County may pursue and utilize additional lawful funding sources, including, but not limited to:

- Federal and state transportation grants, including the Michigan Department of Transportation programs;
- Funds from the Michigan Comprehensive Transportation Fund established by Public Act 51 of 1941;
- Millage revenues if separately authorized; and,
- Intergovernmental agreements.

7. The County Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to:

- Prepare and execute all necessary documents;
- Engage consultants, bond counsel, and financial advisors;
- File required applications and approvals; and,
- Take all actions necessary to implement the Transportation System and financing.

8. All actions taken pursuant to this Resolution shall comply with Act 94 and all other applicable laws of the State of Michigan.

9. Any resolution inconsistent with this Resolution is hereby rescinded.

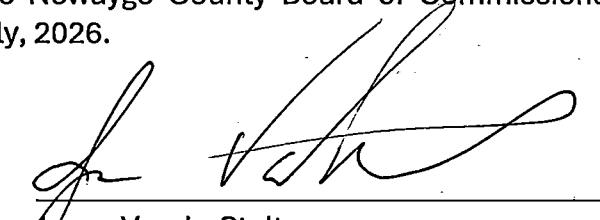

WHEREAS, the Newaygo County Board of Commissioners wishes to monitor and account for the activities of these projects in a separate enterprise fund; and

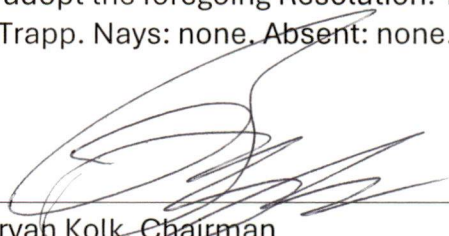
WHEREAS, this fund will be used for transportation system activities, which are not funded by voter-approved bonds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Newaygo County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes Fund 588: Transportation System Fund.

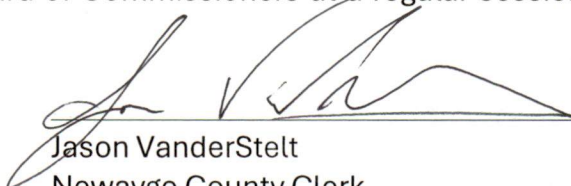
