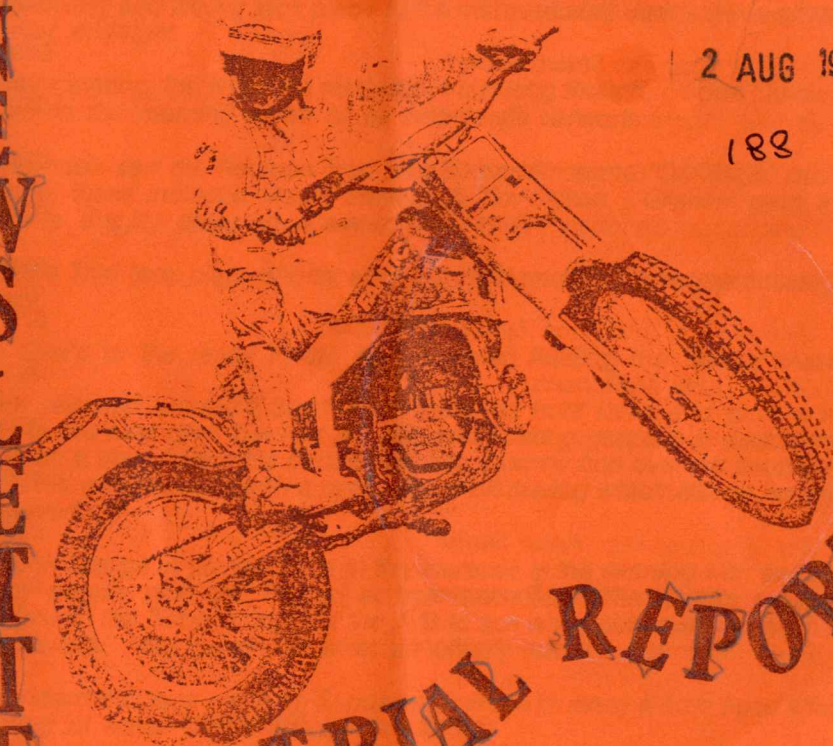

The Crowthorne Challenge

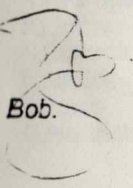
