Kent Youth Trials Club (KYTC) offer a fun and engaging motor sport to youth riders aged between 4 and 21 years on electric and petrol motorcycles. It is a skill-based sport where balance and control of your machine is key, not speed!

We hold 14 competitive trials, plus 8 demonstration days at various locations across the county each year. We also offer camping weekends for those who wish to enjoy the social aspect of the sport.

Trophies and medals are awarded at each trial, as well as at our annual awards evening.

Club riders are eligible to ride at other club's trials and compete at a National level.

Previous riders who have now exceeded the youth age range regularly visit and help the younger riders practice and learn new skills.
