Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

I am amazed at how my four siblings teach their many kids in age-appropriate ways. For example, now that my nephew Brandon is 24 years of age, they give him insights and freedoms that would have been positively confounding or even dangerous when he was a toddler. Imagine if they had taught him at age four how to drive a car, use a credit card online, or handle power tools. But eventually, they did, and he is a high functioning young man, I'm proud to say. They are good teachers.

This week we learn that Jesus teaches us in a similar way. He says to his Apostles, **"I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now" (John 16:12)**. How disappointing for them. But imagine at that moment, before his resurrection and ascension, if the Lord had started telling them about synods and sacraments, popes and parishes, martyrs and monasteries, rosaries and relics, catechisms and crucifixes? They would have been absolutely overwhelmed, confused, and discouraged. He tells them what they need to know, when it is time for them to know it.

So he does for us. Jesus has unceasingly taught the Church as she matures through the centuries, just as he teaches you and me through our lives in ways we can understand. Our task should be to learn what he is teaching us now, knowing that (although revelation per se is complete in him and his Apostles), he never ceases to teach us as we spiritually mature. Be confident: he knows what you are ready to learn now.

“¿Tienes un misterio para mí que resolver?” Sí, lo he escuchado una vez, lo he escuchado cien veces. Mi hija está obsesionada con los misterios. No le basta con leer sobre ellos en las páginas de todos los libros de Nancy Drew que puede conseguir. Ella quiere más que eso. Quiere un misterio de la vida real. Un rompecabezas que se resiste a ser resuelto. Una pregunta que elude una respuesta. Algo que no es fácil de comprender. No me sorprende que ella no esté satisfecha con los “misterios” que puedo ofrecerle. El misterio del lazo para el cabello perdido de mamá (spoiler: estaba en mi bolso). El misterio del jamón del almuerzo perdido (ups, mamá lo terminó). Las respuestas simples son muy aburridas. “¿Tendré alguna vez un verdadero misterio?” se queja ella. Lo entiendo. Todos somos así en realidad. Nos sentimos atraídos por lo misterioso, por lo inescrutable. Es porque sabemos que las respuestas a las preguntas realmente importantes son aquellas que no se pueden explicar de forma clara y ordenada. Sabemos que la realidad de la vida, el amor y la condición humana es algo que no podemos comprender. Sabemos que hay tantas cosas en este mundo, en este universo, que no podemos...comprender. Entonces, de cierto modo, los misterios son las únicas cosas que, en realidad, tienen sentido para nosotros. ¿Por qué amamos tanto los misterios? Porque Dios es un misterio. Eso nunca ha sido tan claro como lo es ahora, en la Fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad, el misterio que nos desconcierta a todos. Cuatro relaciones. Tres personas. Un Dios. No me pidas que te lo explique. Podría, pero no tengo el espacio para explicarlo, y, francamente, puede que ni siquiera tenga sentido entonces. Es un misterio, lo ves. Uno de verdad. El mejor de su tipo.

DID YOU KNOW?

Body safety information for young children

Children should know the difference between “okay” and “not okay” or “good” and “bad” touches — touches that are welcome and comforting, and those that are intrusive, unwanted, painful, or uncomfortable. Children should know that they have the right to say “no” to being touched, even to adults, and that no children or adults should touch their private parts unless in very specific circumstances, and for a healthy purpose. This is where it can be helpful to discuss “safe adults,” like doctors, who check our bodies to help keep us healthy, and only in the presence of a parent or trusted adult. Información sobre seguridad corporal para niños pequeños

Los niños deben saber que tienen el derecho de decir “no” a cualquier tipo de contacto no deseado incluso a los adultos, y que ningún niño o adulto deben tocar las partes íntimas salvo en circunstancias muy concretas y con fines sanitarios o médicos. Puede ser útil hablar de “adultos de confianza”, como los doctores que revisan nuestros cuerpos para ayudar a mantenernos sanos, y sólo en presencia de un padre o un adulto de confianza.
