Ontario has proposed a standalone heat stress regulation under the Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA), aiming to introduce specific requirements for all workplaces. With the introduction of Bill 222, employers will be required to implement a Worker Heat Protection Program and with this in mind residents should be prepared for unpredicted landfill closures. The safety of our staff and residents takes precedence over disposal needs.

Knowing what to do should a fire occur is very important. **Have a fire safety plan** for your home, cottage, trailer, or workplace and practice it with the family. If everyone knows what to do in the event of a fire, they will be calmer and will be able to move to a safe place more quickly; this includes children. Test smoke and CO alarms monthly. Change batteries when you change your clocks.
