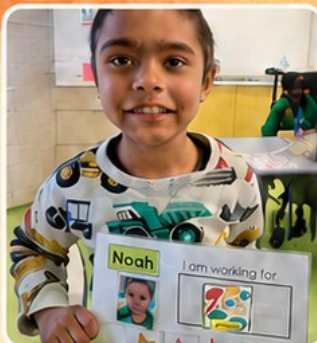




The students also enjoyed exploring how a plant begins as a seed and grows through different stages. They are learning what plants need to grow and developing their understanding of the world around them.

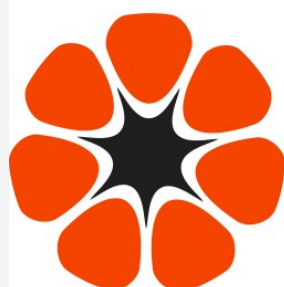
