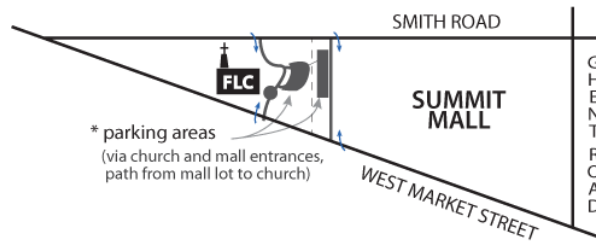
History
