# General Price List

The goods and services shown here are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

## Professional Services of Funeral Director & Staff...

### Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

Our fee for the basic services of Funeral Director and staff includes, but is not limited to: (1) responding to the initial request for service; (2) conducting the arrangement conference; (3) preparation of biographical and statistical data; (4) examination of financial settlement options; (5) preparation and filing of papers, permits and authorizations; (6) coordination with those providing other services; (7) preparation and placement of obituary notices; (8) retention and care of remains prior to commencement of post death activities; (9) the availability of staff on a 24 hour basis (10) overhead expenses relative to our facility and operations, such as occupancy, administrative and equipment costs, insurance, maintenance, utilities, inventory, as well as portions of those expenses incurred in providing health care & pension retirement benefits

This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

◆ Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff.....\$ 2,675

### Embalming (Including use of preparation room and sanitary care)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a public viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation, immediate burial or green burial. If you choose to have embalming performed, the decedent may be embalmed at another location other than this registered mortuary.

*No human remains may remain unburied or uncremated in New Jersey for more than 48 hours unless embalmed or refrigerated. (N.J.A.C.8:9-1.1)*

Use of facilities, staff and equipment for Viewing/Visitation, including setup of the visitation area, placement of remains, positioning of floral displays, and supervision and attendance during the hours of visitation.

## Funeral Ceremony

Use of facilities, staff and equipment for the Funeral Ceremony, including coordinating the arrangements for the ceremony, staff supervision and attendance, and the use of the funeral home when used for the ceremony.

## Memorial Service (without body present)

Our services include coordinating the arrangements for the memorial service, staff supervision and attendance, and the use of the funeral home when used for the memorial service.

## Use of Staff for Graveside Service (whether at cemetery or crematory)

Our services include supervision, attendance and accompaniment of the remains to the cemetery or crematory.

# Transportation...

All local transfer and transportation fees are based on a radius within 10 miles of the Funeral Home. Additional distance is charged at the local rate plus \$2.00 per mile.

This General Price List does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to handle for you such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers, clergy honorariums, gratuities and newspaper notices.

Forwarding of Remains To Another Funeral Home..... \$2,475

This package charge includes removal of remains to this funeral home (local, within 10 miles), basic services of Funeral Director and staff, the basic sheltering of remains, embalming, obtaining necessary permits. It does not include a casket or alternative or shipping container, the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to forwarding the remains, or any sheltering for days on which no post death activities occur. Nor does it include transferring the remains to the airport or other destination, or the charges of a common carrier, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

Receiving of Remains From Another Funeral Home..... \$1,750

This package charge includes receiving the remains from the other funeral home, the basic sheltering of the remains, basic services of Funeral Director and staff, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, and local (within 10 miles) transportation to the cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial or cremation, or any sheltering for days on which no post death activities occur. Nor does it include transferring the remains from the airport or other source, or the charges of a common carrier, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

Our package charges for direct cremation include basic services of Funeral Director and staff, the local (within 10 miles) transfer of remains to the funeral home, the basic sheltering of the remains, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, local transportation to the crematory, sanitary care and preparation of remains for identification. This charge does not include the use of facilities or staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to cremation, or any sheltering for days on which no post death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the cremation process, which is a crematory charge, or any other cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are corrugated cardboard alternative containers.

Our package charges include basic services of Funeral Director and staff, the local (within 10 miles) transfer of remains to the funeral home, the basic sheltering of the remains, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations and local transportation to the cemetery, sanitary care and preparation of the remains for identification. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial, or any sheltering for days on which no post death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the grave at the cemetery, or the cemetery's charges for opening and closing of the grave, any required outer burial container or cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

# Green Burial Package

Green Burial to Local NJ Cemeteries (Sustainable Casket by purchaser)..... \$4,975

Our package charges include basic services of Funeral Director and staff, the local (within 10 miles) transfer of remains to the funeral home, the basic cleansing and shrouding (Cotton/Bamboo Shroud) of the body, the basic sheltering of the remains (up to 48 hours), the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, local transportation to the cemetery, and the attendance and accompaniment of the remains to the graveside by one of our licensed funeral directors. This charge does not include a sustainable casket or lowering device, or the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, at the funeral home or vigil at the family home, prior to burial. Nor does it include the actual cost of the grave at the cemetery, or the cemetery's charges for opening and closing of the grave, any required cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.
