These prices are effective as of October 1, 2025 and are subject to change without notice. The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. (However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our services and overhead.) If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods & services you selected.

Basic Services of Funeral Director & Staff \$2,995

Our charge includes consultation with the family or responsible party; staff and facilities to respond to initial requests for service; preparing and filing necessary notices, assistance with writing and submitting obituary, coordinating service plans with clergy, cemetery, crematory and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased; notifying Social Security of death; completing and filing the death certificate; securing official documents and necessary authorizations; sheltering of the deceased for five (5) days. In addition, this fee includes basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding and receiving of remains.)

Professional Care & Preparation of Remains

Embalifing	
Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law.	
Embalming may be necessary however if you select certain funeral	
arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want	
embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement	
that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or	
immediate burial. For both public health and aesthetic reasons, we	
require embalming for open-casket public viewings. Embalming may	/
also be recommended to preserve the body between the time of	
death and the disposition of the deceased. Our licensed professional	ls
reserve the right to require embalming based on the condition of th	e
remains and service requirements.

Forwarding Remains to Another

Funeral Home\$2,965

This charge includes *local transfer of decedent to our care, basic services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations, transportation to local airport during regular business hours. This charge does not include shipping cost, visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the remains.

Receiving Remains to From Another Funeral Home\$2,135

This charge includes receipt of remains, basic services of staff, unpacking, care and shelter of remains, *transfer of remains to local cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include any visitation, rites or ceremonies.

Immediate Burial\$2,985 to \$10,235

Our charge for an immediate burial, without viewing, attendant rites, ceremonies or witnesses, includes *local transfer of remains to our care, sanitary care (no embalming), refrigeration, dressing and casketing, *local transportation to the cemetery, supervision of interment, and necessary services of staff and authorizations. This is a discounted service package. If you wish additional service items, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) Funeral Rule requires that ALL items must be itemized from the General Price List.

Direct Cremation\$2,915 to \$10,165

This charge for direct cremation includes *local transfer of remains to our care, necessary authorizations, limited services of staff, refrigeration, transfer to and from crematory, cremation permit, standard cremation process fee†, recyclable urn, and one (1) certified death certificate. This charge does not include the use of facilities or staff for any visitation, viewing or ceremony, public or private, prior to or after cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are constructed of heavy corrugated board. This is a discounted service package. If you wish additional service items, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) Funeral Rule requires that ALL items must be itemized from the General Price List.

Choices Related To Payment

To lose someone you love is a devastating human experience. It can be traumatic and seriously impact one's judgment. Therefore, it is important to be realistic with respect to funeral expenditures.

We do not want your choices to be more than what you consider affordable nor less than you would like to arrange. What is important is that the arrangements are in keeping with your wishes and budget.

We believe in the recognition and meaningful celebration of a life and will assist in creating an appropriate service to meet your needs. For your convenience, we accept the following methods of payment.

Third-Party Items — Payment for cemetery, clergy, church, newspaper notices, radio announcements, or other third-party items is required in the form of a check or cash at the time of arrangements because each of these requires payment when their services is provided. Unfortunately, since these are not our charges, we cannot accept credit cards or life insurance policies for these items.

Funeral Home Charges — We are a small family-owned business that strives to treat every family we serve fairly and equally. To provide the finest services and merchandise possible while minimizing our cost to do so, we are dependent upon our clients for arranging payment at the time of arrangements.

Payment may be made in the following manner:

- 1) Prepaid Funeral Fund Proceeds
- 2) Cash, personal check, bank check or money order
- 3) Visa, MasterCard, Discover
- 4) Life Insurance, so long as the policy is verified, in-force, unencumbered, non-contestable and assigned to the funeral home. All verified beneficiaries must sign the required insurance processing documents and claim forms prior to services being scheduled. The processing company charges a fee of 5% of the total amount of the assignment.
- 5) Third-Party Financing is available through Family Shield Credit. The application process can be completed in our office or through our website. Approval process typically takes just a few minutes. Applying will not impact your credit score.
