Qualifications:

- 1) Age 15-21(as of January 1st) and lives in or attends the following school districts:
Manheim Central, Donegal, Hempfield, Elizabethtown, Manheim Township or Warwick.
- 2) Agree to serve a one-year term (October to October)
- 3) Complete the Junior Board application.

Responsibilities:

- 1) Support the Manheim Community Farm show in our mission to promote agriculture, crafts and competition in a friendly environment that encourages family values and cooperation.
- 2) Maintain a professional and cooperative attitude with volunteers and attendees
- 3) Use appropriate dress, behavior (including no tobacco) and language when representing the farm show
- 4) Support the decisions of the Junior Board and the Board of Directors
- 5) Attend assigned committee meetings, junior board meetings and Executive Committee meetings in February, June and August.
- 6) Engage in Farm Show activities such as:
 - a) Assist/shadow any board member in farm show business
 - b) Support the BBQ fundraiser with sales and distribution
 - c) Participate in sign up genius needs
 - d) Participate in the implementation and decision making

Buildings and Grounds. ()
