- **BBIG Project Meeting.** The virtual BBIG Project Meeting was held May14th and 15th. Project directors Project directors reported to the Advisory Panel members on the extensive accomplishments since September 1, 2020, and sought their feedback.
- Deadline extended for the focus issue of PhytoFrontiers Reclaiming Boxwood from the Blight. Per suggestion from the American Phytopathological Society (APS), the deadline for manuscript submission was extended from August 1 to September 1, 2025. This extension is to allow APS to reach out to its thousands members on this important focus issue using different publicizing venues, including the upcoming annual meeting Plant Health 2025.
