GOSPEL REFLECTION

I am embarrassed to admit that I frequently find myself dining and socializing with people who have millions and sometimes billions of dollars. I've eaten more caviar, lobster and wagyu steak than most people on the planet. I justify it by saying it's part of my job. But I have seven pairs of nice jeans and expensive shoes.

So it is rather uncomfortable to hear Our Lord say: "My child, remember that you received what was good in your lifetime, while Lazarus likewise received what was bad; but now he is comforted here, whereas you are tormented" (Luke 16:25). Fellow rich people (and if you're American, you're rich), do we not vehemently though quietly object to this parable's karma-esque reward system? Why bless the rich man just to curse him later? And curse Lazarus just to bless him later? So Americans go to hell, while Burundians and Afghans go to heaven? What is going on?

One clue is that the condemned rich man doesn't complain of injustice. Rather, he simply begs to help his brothers to repent. Of what? We don't know exactly. Perhaps another clue is that the rich man now seems more like the downtrodden Lazarus. He knows what it is to be hungry and thirsty, to be wounded in the gutter; that he deserved that, not fancy meals and clothes. Maybe the rich man finally understands how to receive true blessings, but it is too late for him. But not for me. Not for us.

BECOME A PARISHIONER

Church membership is an obligation of discipleship and love that derives from being united with Christ. At the Cathedral, active membership is a requirement for the celebration of a marriage or baptism, for one to be eligible to be a Godparent or Confirmation sponsor, and for special benefits such as tuition subsidy at a Catholic school. There are certain minimum requirements for parish membership called the precepts of the Church. The following are three of those precepts and how we look upon them in relation to parish membership.

ATTENDANCE AT WEEKLY MASS. The first precept of the Church requires the faithful to participate in the Eucharistic celebration when the Christian community gathers together on the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord (CCC #2042) and on holy days of obligation (CCC #2043). Since the Cathedral's weekly Mass attendance envelopes are the primary way we determine if parishioners are regularly attending Mass, parishioners must place their envelopes in the collection basket every Sunday regardless of whether one makes a financial contribution or donates online.

RECEIPT OF THE SACRAMENTS. The third and fourth precept of the Church state that the faithful must ensure preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the Sacrament of Penance at least once a year, and the reception of Holy Communion at least once a year during the Easter season (CCC #2042) and to join in fast and abstinence during Lent.

SUPPORT OF THE CHURCH. The fifth precept of the Church states that the faithful have the duty of providing for the material needs of the Church, each according to their abilities in a regular, identifiable, and meaningful way.

CHILDREN'S CHOIR

THE CATHEDRAL OF SAINT PATRICK CHILDREN'S CHOIRS



The Cathedral of St. Patrick offers as one of its ministries a quality choral music program for children in grades 2-8 that is both fun and rewarding.

2ND GRADE CHOIR

The 2nd grade cathedral choir serves as an introduction to basic vocal technique, music theory, and the importance of working together as a musical group. They practice 30 minutes each week and sing one Sunday a month at the 9am Mass at St. Patrick's during the school year and for the annual Cathedral Advent/Christmas Concert.

3RD-8TH GRADE CHOIR

The 3rd-8th grade choir uses a choir workbook—*Voices for Life*—and practices an hour weekly. They sing one Sunday a month at the 9am Mass at St. Patrick's during the school year and for the annual Cathedral Christmas Concert.

FEES: All choir members are asked to purchase a choir shirt (\$24). 3rd-8th graders purchase a choir workbook (approximately \$8).

In addition, the choir will have full choir practices approximately every 6 weeks on Sunday evenings at 5pm. There will be no Tuesday, Thursday or Saturday practices the week prior to full choir practices, and they are followed by pizza and fellowship at 6pm.

Who is Petro Oros?

- Greek Catholic Bishop of Eparchy of Mukachevo, who celebrated sacraments in secret during the Soviet occupation of Western Ukraine in the 1940's [at a time when the Ruthenian Byzantine church was outlawed]
- Martyred in 1953; gunned down at a train station
- Recognized by Pope Francis in 2022 for his dedication to the church and care for the poor
- Formal Beatification ceremony will take place in Rome on September 27th, 2025
- Beatification (2nd step in the canonization process) is when an individual is declared "Blessed", worthy of limited public veneration & honored for his holiness
