

Cathedral of St. Patrick MACS Family Parish Participation Agreement

Please fill out this document to request certification as an actively participating family at the Cathedral of St. Patrick for MACS tuition purposes.

Please note that a family must be registered and actively participating at the Cathedral for at least 6 months before requesting this discount.

The responsibilities and commitments of actively participating families are described below. Please read each statement carefully and indicate that you agree by initialing below each line. Both parents must add their initials to each statement and sign at the end.

Preamble

We understand that, according to MACS policy:

In order to support participating Catholic families, MACS offers a Participating Catholic tuition rate to eligible families. To receive this discounted rate, families must be registered at a local parish within the Diocese of Charlotte and both parents and children together should be actively engaged in the life of their parish. Active participation includes, at a minimum,

- *Mass attendance on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation*
- *Service to the parish through time, talent, and treasure*
- *Up to date on Sacraments*

“Mass Attendance on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation”

As a family, parents and children together, we commit to following the Precepts of the Church (CCC 2041-2043), which constitute the minimum obligations of practicing Catholics, namely:

- You shall attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor.
- You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
- You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season.
- You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
- You shall help provide for the needs of the Church.

Concerning these Precepts, we understand the following:

- Sunday Mass attendance as a family is a serious moral and spiritual obligation, and we commit to attending Sunday Mass as a family even when we are on vacation or traveling for youth activities such as sports or for any other reason.
- We understand that attending Mass on weekdays, including school Mass on Fridays, does not fulfill this Sunday obligation.
- In addition to every Sunday of the year, we commit to attending Mass on the Holy Days of Obligation designated by the Church, which are: January 1 (Mary Mother of God), August 15 (Assumption), November 1 (All Saints), December 8 (Immaculate Conception), and December 25 (Christmas).
- We commit as a family to going to the Sacrament of Confession regularly throughout the year.
- We commit to observing the fast (one full meal and two small meals) and abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and to abstaining from meat on all the Fridays in Lent. We understand that the obligations of fasting and abstinence are binding on those between the ages of 14 and 59.

We understand that to be certified as an actively participating family at the Cathedral of St. Patrick, we must attend Sunday Mass at the Cathedral on a majority of Sundays throughout the year, but that Mass attendance in itself does not exhaust the responsibilities of a participating family.

We commit to recording our Mass attendance as a family – parents and children together - by placing our numbered parishioner envelope in the collection basket at every Sunday Mass at the Cathedral of St. Patrick. We understand that we will not be certified as a participating family without this record of Mass attendance.

We understand that online donations will not be counted for the purposes of Mass attendance, nor will envelopes submitted before or after Sunday Mass or during the week.
