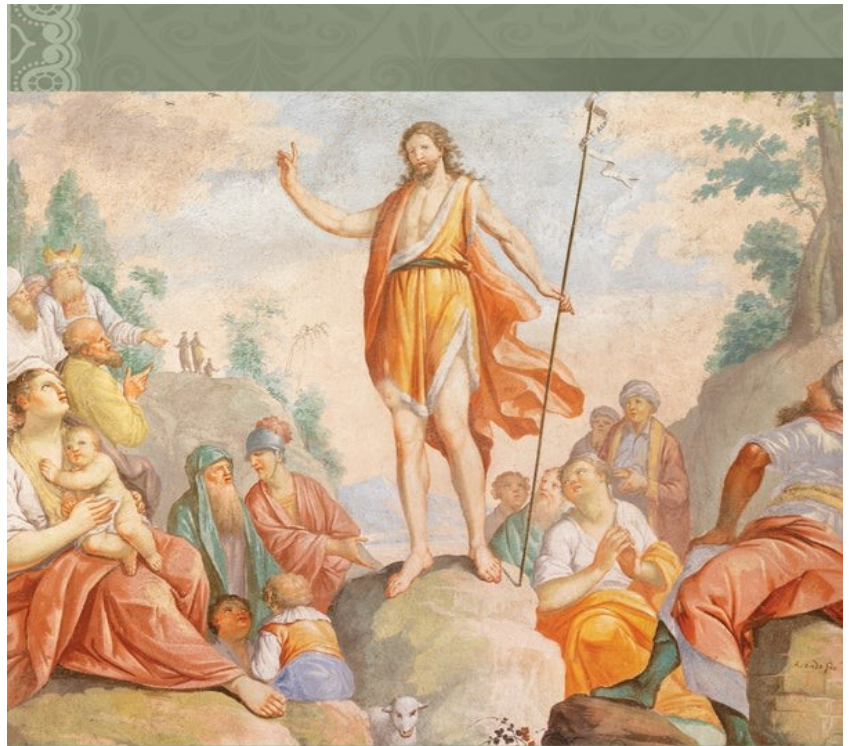

## GOSPEL REFLECTION

During Advent, God gives us the opportunity to work and move, not remain in one place. John the Baptist is our example—he worked tirelessly announcing how to prepare the way of the Lord and what His coming would be like. Isaiah speaks of him: “A voice cries out in the desert: prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths” (John 3:3). Making the paths straight means a conversion from the depths of the heart—a radical yet gentle and firm change to reach God.

“The Church of this time is like a field with grain and chaff mixed together, both good and bad. After the judgment, it will have only the good... He has the winnowing fan to separate the wheat from the chaff. He will store the wheat and burn the chaff in a fire that does not go out” (St. Augustine, Sermon 223).

This Advent is a time to learn that God’s moments are moments of grace. Chaff and wheat grow in us, and it is time to work on conversion to meet the Lord. God expects the best from us and gives us the freedom to follow Him or leave Him. Advent invites us to examine our conscience: how we think, believe, and act.

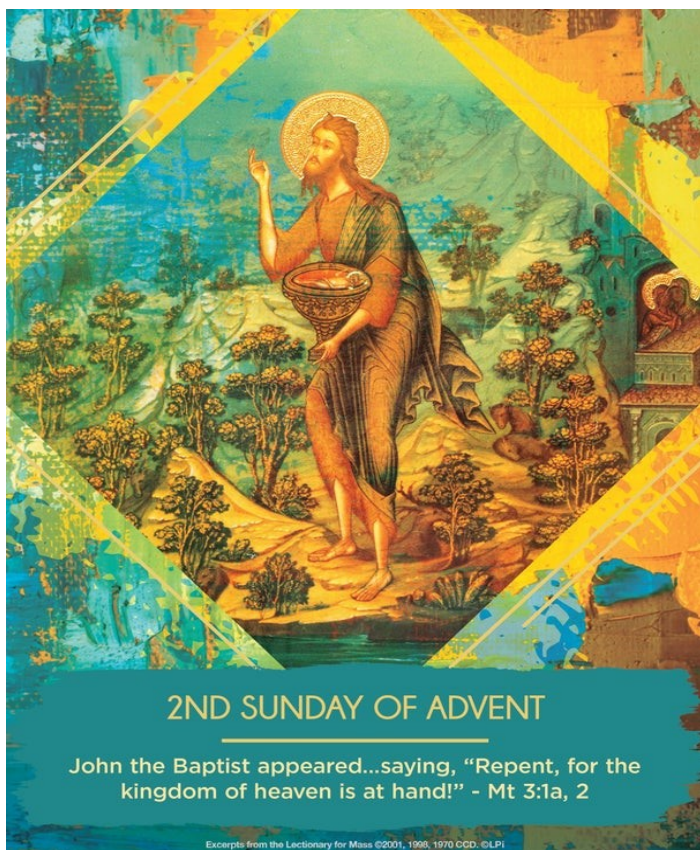

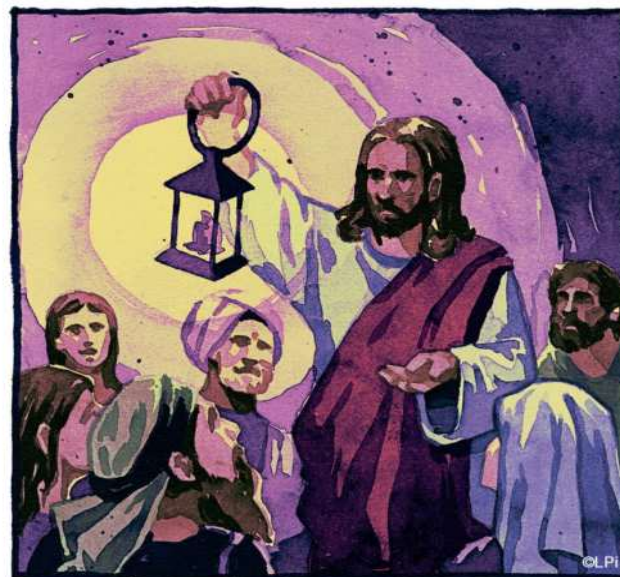




## BASKETBALL GAME

## BECOME A PARISHIONER

Church membership is an obligation of discipleship and love that derives from being united with Christ. At the Cathedral, active membership is a requirement for the celebration of a marriage or baptism, for one to be eligible to be a Godparent or Confirmation sponsor, and for special benefits such as tuition subsidy at a Catholic school. There are certain minimum requirements for parish membership called the precepts of the Church. The following are three of those precepts and how we look upon them in relation to parish membership.

**ATTENDANCE AT WEEKLY MASS.** The first precept of the Church requires the faithful to participate in the Eucharistic celebration when the Christian community gathers together on the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord (CCC #2042) and on holy days of obligation (CCC #2043). Since the Cathedral's weekly Mass attendance envelopes are the primary way we determine if parishioners are regularly attending Mass, parishioners must place their envelopes in the collection basket every Sunday regardless of whether one makes a financial contribution or donates online.

**RECEIPT OF THE SACRAMENTS.** The third and fourth precept of the Church state that the faithful must ensure preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the Sacrament of Penance at least once a year, and the reception of Holy Communion at least once a year during the Easter season (CCC #2042) and to join in fast and abstinence during Lent.

**SUPPORT OF THE CHURCH.** The fifth precept of the Church states that the faithful have the duty of providing for the material needs of the Church, each according to their abilities in a regular, identifiable, and meaningful way.

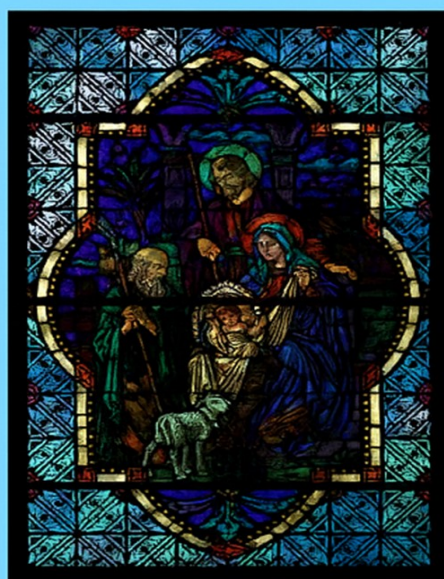

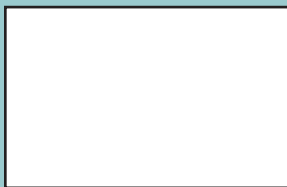

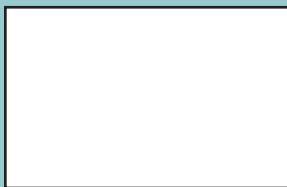
