Please pay attention to those who cross your paths this Advent season. They might well be needing this kind of unconditional acceptance and welcome. Whatever needs they have, whatever failures they've experienced, whatever paths down which they have wandered — please encourage them to "come home."

We'd love to share this hope, this peace, this joy, this love with any and all this season! I so look forward to making this Advent a fresh start for many, many more.
