Blog - A Quilted Labour of Love...

On the 17 December the Kent 'Speak Their Name' memorial suicide quilt was installed in our worship space. This is a real labour of love created by family members in Kent who have lost loved ones to suicide (see Page 5). It is a painful reminder that tragedy can befall any of us. The quilt will remain on display with us until 14 January when it moves on to Canterbury. If you haven't yet had the opportunity of studying this beautiful and very moving work of love, then can I urge you to do so. What impacted me most was the number of young people from all ethnic backgrounds who felt compelled to end their lives. It was truly heart breaking.

When I was told that the quilt would be with us during Christmas, I was disappointed. It seemed to clash with the celebrations and light heartedness of the season. It brought a very different mood to events. But, as I reflected on this more, I came to see it in a different way, because the actual events of that first Christmas were in fact very grim. Homelessness, fear and terror are all part of what the Holy Family endured – not to mention Mary giving birth in such inauspicious surroundings. Moreover, for many people in Medway and throughout the world, life is a real struggle and hardship. And those realities don't change just because it happens to be Christmas.

The real message of Christmas is that God comes down to our messy and hurting world. He doesn't shy away from pain and suffering but rather immerses himself in the harsh realities of life. The Memorial quilt might disturb my fluffy idea of Christmas, but it reminds us that God stands with us in our grief and strives to bring renewed hope for those who are grieving and for those struggling with poor mental health.
