Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are all well. I would like to kindly remind everyone of the importance of keeping children at home if they are unwell.

If your child is poorly or has required Calpol (or any other fever-reducing medication) before coming to pre-school, please keep them at home for the day. Medication that reduces fever can mask symptoms, and children are often still contagious even if they seem a little better after a dose. Sending them in while unwell can lead to the spread of illness among other children and staff.

Unfortunately, several staff members are now unwell as a result of recent illnesses circulating in the setting. This impacts our ability to provide the high-quality care and consistency we strive for, so your support in helping to reduce the spread is very much appreciated.

I understand that arranging childcare at short notice can be difficult, and we truly appreciate your cooperation. Our priority is to keep all children healthy, safe, and happy while they are with us.
